



Take 2 DIRECTOR WITH PAUL POWER

Canadian Sean Kelly is a guitarist who fronts his own band-Crash Kelly and he's worked with Alice Cooper, Nelly Furtado, Helix and Gilby Clarke to name just a few. Kelly's book, "Metal on Ice: Tales from Canada's Hard Rock and Heavy Metal Heroes" details his experiences living the 'rock and roll fantasy', offering interesting interviews with a number of Canadian musicians who were key players in the Canuck hard rock scene during the 1980's and early 1990's, as they slugged it out in dingy dives and hockey rinks from the east coast to the west coast, and all points in-between. On page 13 Sean wrote the following paragraph while he was on the Sunset Strip in Hollywood; "The road to Canadian musical glory is not lined with the palm trees of this fabled strip or the top down convertibles I am watching pass by. It is a road slick with black ice, obscured by blizzards and littered with moose and deer that could cause peril for a band strung out from too little sleep and too much excess as they thunder along the Trans-Canada Highway in a cube van." When I read these lines I was immediately hooked. There are nods to small towns in Northwestern Ontario that I was familiar with like Wawa,



North Bay, Kapuskasing, Geraldton, etc. and the litany of Canadian hard rock bands in the book like Sven Gali. Sword, Slik Toxik, Anvil, Voivod, Helix, Harem Scarem, Honeymoon Suite, and many more that I listened to over the years. Most dreamed of getting that elusive record deal and making it big in America, but a lot of the time that very same record deal worked against the artist as they saw their dreams go 'south of the border' in a different way. The book has great insights into how, for instance, Lee Aaron made it big in Europe long before even being considered a serious artist in Canada; how Anvil got screwed over by record labels, and how the whole Grunge movement decimated hard rock and metal-but the internet helped revive it. I read a lot of musicbased books and this one is written for hard rock fans, by a hard rock fan: it's all about the players who dared to dream, and dared to play the game.

TAX TIPS 2021


Tip 1: Repaying your COVID-19 benefits can lower the taxes you owe this year - During the pandemic, the government created benefit programs to support Canadians. You might have received an emergency benefit, like the Canada Emergency Response Benefit (CERB), but later found out you weren't actually eligible for it. The good news is there have been some changes on how you can claim your repayments. What has changed is that, for 2020, 2021 and 2022 only, if you make the repayment in a different year than when you received the benefits, you can choose which year to claim the deduction.

Tip 2: Take advantage of the best method to claim your work-from-home expenses - If you, like many other Canadians, were working from home because of COVID-19, you might have already heard that you can claim some of your home office expenses on your tax return. There are two ways to calculate how much you can claim: the flatrate method and the detailed method.

If you choose to use the flat-rate method, you can claim \$2 for each day you worked at home. The government recently increased the total amount of days you can claim from 200 days to 250 days, which means you can now get up to \$500 back for your expenses.


