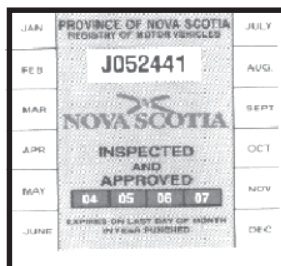

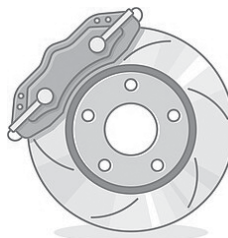

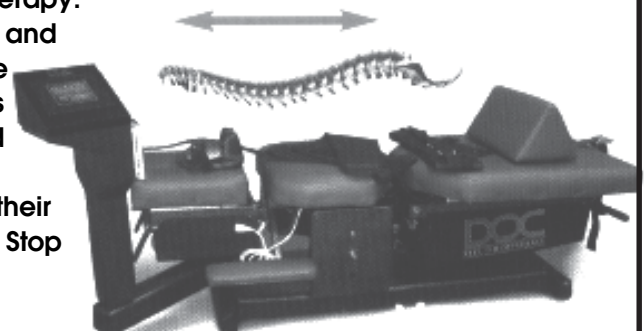

Whenever I read or hear the name Marc Jordan I immediately think of a song that to me personifies summers in the 1970's-of course I'm referring to his memorable hit song "Marina Del Ray". However, one song does not define the artist; Marc has released over 15 albums and wrote songs covered by the likes of Cher, Chicago, Kansas, Kenny Loggins, Olivia Newton John, Diana Ross, Rod Stewart and many more. This is Marc's latest album, scheduled for release later this month, and **"Waiting For The Sun To Rise"** is the title. Being the track jumper that I am I immediately went to Marc's cover of the Tears for Fears song "Everybody Wants To Rule The World", the result is a nice, relaxed jazzy version of the pop hit song. According to Marc this was his first COVID-era project and that may have been the impetus to make an album that looked outward on the state of the world and how we, as individuals, looked inward to deal with things; the album's namesake song certainly



bears that out as Marc waxes poetically on introspection and the power of love and life. There's an almost cinematic quality to a number of the tracks, as they invoke images of places and people-like the smokey "Best Day Of My Life" does. It reminds me of the work Nelson Riddle did with Linda Ronstadt years ago. The same can be said for the cover of Glaswegian band Blue Nile's "The Downtown Lights", to me its the best song on the album, with a perfectly timed rise in the tempo. Marc's son Ezra is featured on backing vocals on a number of the songs-and of course, Ezra's mom is Canadian music legend Amy Sky. Without mentioning every cut here I think it's fair to say that overall Marc and producer Lou Pomanti have crafted a beautiful collection of songs that give warmth, comfort, and entertain the best way possible-through great music.

- TAX TIPS 2022 -**CLAIMING CHILD CARE EXPENSES**

1. SERVICES YOU CAN CLAIM - You can claim the cost of the following services:

Childcare services provided by caregivers (including babysitters and nannies); Nursery schools and daycare centres; Childcare services provided by educational institutions (only the part of your fees related to childcare can be claimed); Day camps and day sports schools where the primary goal of the camp is to care for children (an institution offering a sports study program is not a sports school); or

Boarding schools (excluding the amount relating to education), overnight sports schools, or camps where accommodation is involved.

2. GET YOUR SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS TOGETHER - The first step in making a proper claim is getting a receipt for your childcare expenses from your childcare provider. Every receipt needs to be made out to the person who paid for the childcare expenses. If the childcare services were provided by an individual, the receipt should also show the provider's SIN (Social Insurance Number). You don't have to submit your receipts if you're filing electronically, but you do need to keep them in case the CRA or asks to see them.

3. WHO MAKES THE CLAIM? - The spouse who earns less income will need to claim the childcare expenses on their federal return. Even if the lower income earner doesn't need the deductions, the expenses usually can't be transferred, with a few exceptions - If the spouse who earns less is in school, in the hospital, or if they're confined to a prison or similar institution, childcare expenses can be claimed for that period by the spouse who earns a higher income, or both spouses can split the expenses on their returns. If you're a single parent, you'll claim all the childcare expenses you paid for while your child was living with you.

4. ALL IN THE FAMILY - If you pay your parent (say your mother or father-in-law) to look after your children, you can claim the amount you pay them. Keep in mind they'll have to provide you with a receipt that includes their SIN, and report the money you've paid them as income on their return. However, if your child was looked after by their own parent (for example, their own dad) or their parent's spouse (for example, their stepdad), you won't be able to claim the amount you pay them.

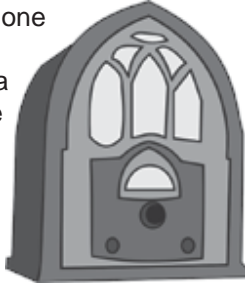

Old Time Radio And Music Podcasts

The Life of Riley was a 30-minute family sitcom that started airing on CBS radio on April 12, 1941. It starred William Bendix as the lead character Chester A. Riley, a simple aircraft plant worker with a very complicated life. "What a revoltin' development this is!" was Riley's famous line in the show, which he usually utter after getting into one mess after another.

Due to its popularity, the show lasted for a decade, with the last episode aired on June 29, 1951. A total of 320 episodes were produced during its entire run. It also has a movie and TV adaptation in the 1950s. The movie adaption was a flop in terms of ratings, although it ironically received the very first Emmy Award. The TV adaptation (with also starred Bendix), on the other hand, was a success, producing more than 200 episodes in its six season run.
