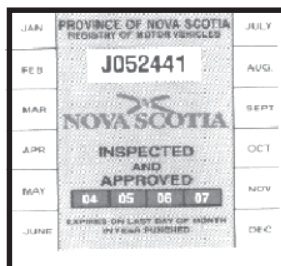

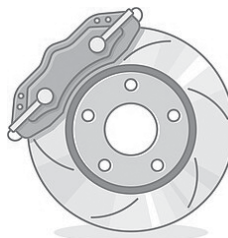

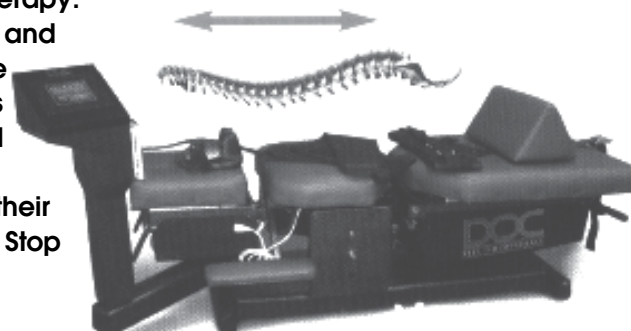

I could write for weeks about the great programming that Netflix offers, especially their original content. I'll admit that I was a bit late joining the party for "Atypical" but was right out of the gate with "Beef". I really like this show but I may have been mistaken thinking that it was a limited series (my favourite kind) as it was never stated whether it was or wasn't a limited episode run. The premise here is something we all can relate to, have experienced, or have done it-road rage. In our basically amped-up OTT society road rage can literally become deadly, and this series shows just how easy one little spark can turn into an all-consuming wildfire. It stars two of my favourite actors; Stephen Yeun (best known as Glen from "The Walking Dead") and stand-up comedian and actress Ali Wong (best known for "American Housewife" and for her raunchy comedy act) and is considered a showcase for great Asian actors, writers and producers. To that end, BuzzFeed.News reporter Izzy Ampil wrote; "But part of what makes Beef so impressive is how confidently it moves



beyond even the most widely accepted tropes of Asian parenthood. It doesn't operate under the illusion that Asian American children are the beleaguered victims of their immigrant parents' poor communication styles. Instead, it exposes how those children make their own bad choices, driven by their own pride, stubbornness, and repression. Beef offers its characters no easy outs; it makes them suffer the consequences of their chaotic actions". The story line covers both sides of "the tracks", from the hipster-rich to the down and out criminal element (both sides of the tracks have very questionable individuals) and how their worlds collide more than you would think. As mentioned above, I hope the producers close the book on "Beef" and not drag out more seasons; no matter how good the beef is it needs an expiry date.

- TAX TIPS 2022 -**MISSED TAX MISTAKES**

MISSING OR MISTAKEN INFORMATION - Some of the most common tax mistakes include double-reporting your income or not accounting for cash you earned from a side gig (that's right, tips are taxable!). Unclaimed income can result in significant penalties, and information missing from your return can be costly.

The government helps you save time and avoid data entry errors with the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA)'s Auto-fill my return (AFR) service and Revenu Québec's Téléchargement des données fiscales (TDF) service.

IT'S ALSO COMMON TO MISS KEY INFORMATION FROM YOUR TAX SLIPS - For example, if you have investments, make sure you keep track of your adjusted cost base (ACB). The ACB is the cost of an investment plus any expenses you paid to buy it, such as commissions and legal fees. If the brokerage you used to manage your investment doesn't know its original cost, they might leave box 20 (the cost or book value) empty on your T5008 slip. If you don't provide this information on your return, you could be overstating your capital gains, which would increase your tax owing or lower your refund.

The best way to avoid accidentally missing information on your return is to consult a tax professional or have someone you trust read over your documents. Have a Tax Expert help you with your return (in person or remotely).

MISSED OPPORTUNITIES - another common mistake is not claiming the benefits and deductions that you're entitled to, missing out on the opportunity to get the highest refund. For example, if you moved this year, you might be eligible to claim your moving expenses, which is often missed. If you sold your home to move, your profit is usually eligible for the principal residence exemption, meaning you won't owe taxes on the capital gains from the sale. However, you'll still need to report the details of the sale on Schedule 3 and form T2091(IND) Designation of a Principal Residence by an Individual. If you're a Québec resident, you'll also have to complete form TP-274-V: Designation of Property as a Principal Residence. Childcare expenses and disability tax credits are a few more common credits and deductions that are missed every year. Additionally, many medical treatments, devices and even items prescribed by medical providers but not completely covered under personal insurance can be claimed as medical expenses. overlooked deductions.
