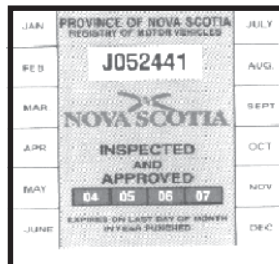

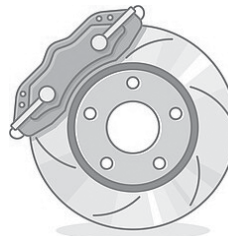

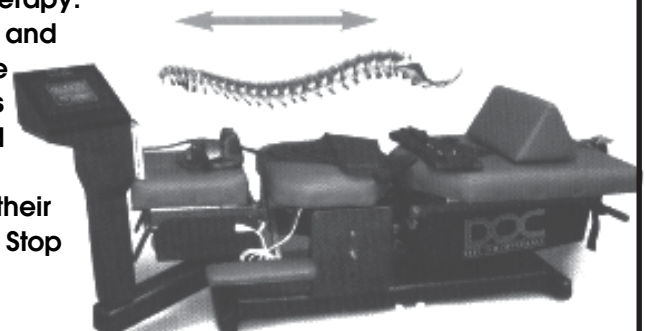

SYDNEY MINES HIGHLAND GAMES SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST 19th

A celebration of Scottish culture and traditions, along with the rich history of coal mining in the area, will take center stage later this summer.

The inaugural Sydney Mines Highland Games is set for Saturday, Aug. 19, from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m., at the Pitt Street Walking Track.

"We are so excited – we want the Games to be a highlight of everyone's summer," Sydney Mines Highland Games Cultural Society Chair Fr. Doug MacDonald says.

A group of community-minded people formed the non-profit society earlier this year with an eye towards creating a fun-filled, free family gathering.

The centerpiece of the International Highland Games Federation (IHGF) sanctioned Games will be the Scottish heavy events, which will feature the crowd-pleasing caber toss.

Sydney Mines native Bryan MacLean will be one of the athletes vying for the inaugural championship – a competition featuring IHGF President Francis Brebner, a former world champion, who will inform and entertain as the announcer.

Along with the heavy events, the Scottish flavor will include Highland dancing and bagpiping. There will be also plenty of food and music, along with activities – such as games and running races – for the children.

The daylong Games, which kick off with the opening ceremonies at 2 p.m., will wrap up with the Scottish concert at 6 p.m.

Along with the walking track location – the former Princess Colliery site in Sydney Mines – the Games will recognize the local legacy of coal mining by naming awards after the pits that once dotted the Northside.

Organizers would like the Games to become the focal point of an annual 'come home week' celebration in the coming years.

Most of you have probably heard all the brouhaha lately about the dangers of AI (artificial intelligence) taking over our world; how that can affect everything from social media and banking, to wars.
