



This past Christmas I was given 2 DVDs that were well-appreciated; "The Gumby Movie" (from 1995) and "The Complete Gumby Show". Of course, some of you who are of a certain 'vintage' remember that little green guy made of clay who brought us hours of joy. Gumby was created in 1955 by Art Clokey and was featured in 2 seasons of the TV series of the same name on NBC. Gumby really was made of green clay and had thicker shins and feet so that he would stand better when Art was doing the painstaking stop motion animation for each show, which were usually under 10 minutes in duration. Clokey actually got his start with an animated short called "Gumbasia"; it generated interest in having a series of children's series done-eventually picked up by NBC, and the rest is-as they say-history. It was in the third episode that a little orange pony named Pokey made his debut and was soon Gumby's partner in adventure. It's true that there's a child-like innocence to these episodes,



but at least they're not fast and flashy; not aimed at a demographic that has a shorter and shorter attention span each year (to me that "In The Night Garden" kids show creeps me out-and looks like it was made by someone who's still on an acid trip) so "The Gumby Show" offers kids a brightly colored and wholesome alternative to marshmallow-minded big screen babysitting shows that dominate the land of kids television these days. It was actually Eddie Murphy's recurring skits as a cranky Gumby on Saturday Night Live that revived "The Gumpy Show" for 99 episodes in 1988, adding to the little green one's legacy. So why should you watch this stuff? To quote Eddie Murphy; "I am Gumby dammit"...so enjoy.

OWEN HANN

When It comes to the little TOWN OF NORTH SYDNEY NOVA SCOTIA not everything is little.

THE NORTHSIDE IS KNOWN FOR SOME PRETTY BIG TIME TALENT. And with so much musical talent flowing through his veins, Owen was as versatile as you can get. a bassist who could play any type of music. And knowing him well, his favourite style of music was the Blues.

Owen began to play for many CAPE BRETON BANDS Including Sam Moon in the 1970s, "The Battery" Which released an album titled "Tomorrow" back in 1981 on the RIO RECORDS LABEL and he co-wrote 3 songs for that Album. In the mid 80s he went on to play with the band "Spider" and then "The Black Cats" into the 90s before moving to Summerside PEI.

Owen had also provided the awesome bass track on my song "Hooked On Country" from my 1998 album "Raised On Country" that was recorded back in 1997 at Lakewind Sound Point Auconi NS. After moving to Summerside Owen played with the Johnny Ross band which became "Old Habits"

Then for 10 years played with a band that he put together called "The West end Blues Band" And then most recently had played with a group called "Route 225". He was an Assistant Meat Manager at the Atlantic Super Store in Summerside PEI, And was just getting ready to retire in April of 2023.

His plan was simple, to spend most of his time with his Family, his wife Rita and children, Nicholas (Lisa) and Brittanny (Brett). And his three grand children Knox, Daxx and Sutton. My dear brother-in-law Owen Hann passed away on December the 25th 2022 of all days "Christmas Day"

And just like Owen and all the other great maritime musicians gone before him, they have certainly left there imprint in music. Not only was he respected by fellow musicians that new him, but to anyone who have been moved by his stage presence and wonderful talent. Owen Hann has just made Heaven's massive talented orchestra that much better.
