PAUL POWER

I'm looking back at an album from 1993 that wasn't well-received at the time, but in retrospect deserves a total re-think. It's the fifth album released by British singer William Broad. He enjoyed great success with his previous albums, and when he released the 1990 album "Charmed Life" he suffered a broken leg in a motorcycle accident. While recovering he was interviewed by legendary rock journalist Legs McNeil who noticed the electronic muscle stimulator on William's leg-referring to him as a "cyberpunk". William then took a serious interest in the works of author William Gibson, having read the book "Neuromancer" in the mid-1980s. Over the next 3 years he looked more into cyberpunk fiction and technology. This led to the release of this concept album with Broad's first attempt at using computers in making his music. The album was very experimental for its time, and a groundbreaker for using new digital media tools. William Broad went on to set several precedents in promoting the new album;



using the internet, email lists, virtual communities and multi-media software; no other artist had done anything like this before. The album has a cyberpunk storyline, as well as synthesized vocals and industrial sounds; Broad then based his fashion style, music videos, and stage shows on the theme of cyberpunk. Not many hits came from the album; "Shock To The System" was the only one, based on the 1992 Los Angeles riots, and the music video for the song was totally groundbreaking, influencing music videos to come, and polarizing the internet. Haters said it was an act of 'opportunistic commercialism' and that it was part of a process that over-used the term "cyberpunk", eventually causing the word to lose some meaning. However, many saw Broad's efforts as harmless and honest. Looking back, this album was ahead of its time. By the way, William Broad is better known as Billy Idol - the album's name? "Cyberpunk".

"Everything comes in circles - even Professor Moriarty It's all been done before, and will be again." So said Holmes, and he was right. Conan Doyle killed Holmes off in disgust, but had to "resurrect" him and continue the tales.

Sherlock Holmes episodes on radio are often dismissed, as are the many films. Yet for his fans and all lovers of mystery, the swirling London fogs, murder most foul, odd villains and an upper class becoming modern as London's denizens struggle in pitiful poverty means "the game is afoot!" Holmes actually has a long and wonderful history on the radio. For American radio, the heroine of Holmes on the radio was Edith Meiser, an actress who loved the stories and was convinced they would make great listening. Beginning in the early 1930s, she single handed wrote the show for over a dozen years, first working from the Conan Doyle canon, and then continuing to create stories in the spirit of the originals.

TAX TIPS

What income do I need to report as a summer student?

Whether you're a full-time employee, part time, seasonal or occasional, income earned should be reported to the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA). Your company is also informing the CRA of the money they paid you through a form called the T4, which they'll also send to you around February for the previous year's earnings.

If you work somewhere where earnings wouldn't show up on a T4 slip, such as tips from a restaurant job, it's your responsibility to keep track of how much you earned in tips and report that amount to the CRA as well.

However, if you earn under the basic personal amount (which was \$13,808 for 2021 taxes), you likely won't have any taxes owing and therefore aren't required to file. But if legally you aren't required to file, there are other reasons to do so, including receiving the quarterly GST/HST tax credit if you're 19 or over, which could bring you another \$467 per year. Also, if the company deducts Canadian Pension Plan (CPP) funds from your paycheck, you're likely to get some of that back with your refund.
