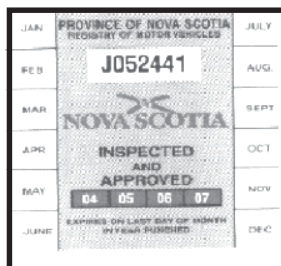

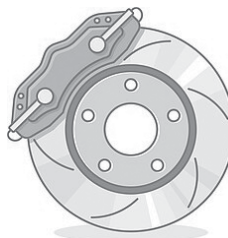

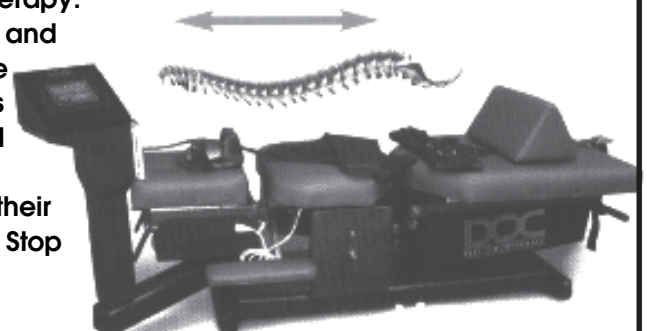

The Emerald Isle is a place that's steeped in tradition, history, superstition and mystery; with St. Patrick's Day just 2 days away I have something timely to write about. Of course Leprechauns are a big part of that celebration, but what about the 'other' wee ones that live in the lush forests and rolling hills of Ireland? **"Unwelcome"** is a new movie that deals with the not so happy-go-lucky little ones in Ireland known as the "Far Darrig", "Fear Dearg" or "Red Hats", depending on who you are talking to. This story follows young couple Jamie and Maya who live in London. Maya is pregnant and as they start to celebrate the good news they experience a home invasion by a gang of hooligans. After the assault the couple move to rural Ireland after Jamie's great-aunt Maeve wills them a house and property. I've been to Ireland so when Jamie said "it's so green here" he's absolutely right, but that emerald landscape sometimes hides very dark secrets. The Far Darrig here are indeed terrifying, which is made even more so by what first appears to be



a giggly and playful nature-until the knives come out, literally. I also give the producers credit got not punking out and using cheap CGI to create the demons-the masks and costumes are amazing. This movie is like a cross between "Straw Dogs" and "Gremlins", if the Gremlins were violent cannibals that is! The film looks great, with the use of drone visuals, long and mood-inducing shots and atmospheric lighting-and great use of the deep, dark and lush forests that almost have an other-worldly look and feel to them. I particularly liked the look of the stone wall and gate in the couple's backyard. All in all, this is a fun romp that's a great viewing option for St. Paddy's Day-but a bigger horror is that stupid American tradition of green beer! May the leprechauns dance over your bed and bring you sweet dreams.

## Old Time Radio And Music Podcasts

Blondie was a radio situation comedy adapted from the long-run Blondie comic strip by Chic Young. The radio program had a long run on several networks from 1939 to 1950. After Penny Singleton was cast in the title role of the feature film Blondie (1938), co-starring with Arthur Lake as Dagwood, she and Lake repeated their roles December 20, 1938, on The Bob Hope Show. The appearance with Hope led to their own show, beginning July 3, 1939, on CBS as a summer replacement for The Eddie Cantor Show. However, Cantor did not return in the fall, so the sponsor, Camel Cigarettes chose to keep Blondie on the air Mondays at 7:30 pm. Camel remained the sponsor through the early WWII years until June 26, 1944.



In 1944, Blondie was on the Blue Network, sponsored by Super Suds, airing Fridays at 7pm from July 21 to September 1. The final three weeks of that run overlapped with Blondie's return to CBS on Sundays at 8 pm from August 13, 1944, to September 26, 1948, still sponsored by Super Suds.

Beginning in mid-1945, the 30-minute program was heard Mondays at 7:30 pm. Super Suds continued as the sponsor when the show moved to NBC on Wednesdays at 8 pm from October 6, 1948, to June 29, 1949.

## - TAX TIPS 2022 -

### FORGOTTEN TAX DEDUCTIONS

I think of ones that have come in recently ... things like the interest paid on your student loans, which generates a tax credit, or the homebuyers amount, which generates a tax credit, those are relatively new. ... Unless you're regularly reading them or working with a professional, you might not know you qualify for these newer credits."

The medical expense credit can cover a variety of out-of-pocket costs such as prescriptions, eyeglasses, private healthcare premiums, dental visits and medical devices, Knipfel says. The rules for claiming medical expenses are also very unique, he adds, because it's based on any 12-month period ending within the taxation year, rather than the calendar year itself, and can include amounts paid for dependents.

Tax credits reduce the amount of money owed to the Canada Revenue Agency. Most tax credits are non-refundable, meaning they can lower your tax liability but can't boost your tax refund or be used to create a refund.

For Canadians who are caring for a parent or who have renovated their home to improve accessibility for a qualifying individual, they should keep the caregiver tax credit and home accessibility expense tax credit in mind, according to Brian Quinlan, a partner at accounting firm Allay LLP.

Those who have purchased their first home can take advantage of the first-time home buyers tax credit, which was increased to \$10,000 for the 2022 tax year and can provide a credit of up to \$1,500, Quinlan says.

Other credits that Canadians often forget are available to them are the digital news subscription credit, an adoption tax credit, and for investors, the foreign tax credit, he adds.

"Tax withheld on foreign company dividends (say Apple Inc.) can be claimed as a credit against your Canadian tax liability, so you don't end up paying tax to two countries on the same income," Quinlan said.

With mental health front and centre as the country emerges from the pandemic, the disability tax credit is another underutilized benefit because many think it's mainly for physical disabilities.

Don't forget about tax deductions - While tax credits lower the amount of tax owed, tax deductions reduce the income of an individual who is subject to tax.

An often-forgotten tax deduction is the work-from-home deduction that was introduced during the pandemic for those working remotely. Canadians who are still working remotely can take advantage of the simplified rule for home office expenses and claim a deduction of up to \$500 for 2022.
