





Old Time Radio And Music Podcasts

The New Adventures of Sherlock Holmes was an old-time radio show which aired in the USA from October 2, 1939 to July 7, 1947. Originally, the show starred Basil Rathbone as Sherlock Holmes and Nigel Bruce as Dr. Watson. Together, they starred in

220 episodes which aired weekly on Mondays from 8:30 to 9:00 pm. Bromo Quinine sponsored some of the earlier programs on the NBC Blue Network and for a period Parker Pen was the sponsor. The show first aired on the Blue Network but later moved to the Mutual Broadcasting System.

Basil Rathbone's last episode as the famous detective was "The Singular Affair of the Baconian Cipher." He was eager to sepa-



rate himself from the cast type of Holmes, and even though the show's sponsor Petri Wine offered him generous pay to continue, he decided to move on. Once he did, the sponsor did as well, and Tom Conway took the starring role, though Nigel Bruce got top billing and was always announced first. The new sponsor was Kreml Hair Tonic for Men, and the new series only lasted 39 episodes.

- TAX TIPS 2022 -

NEW FOR 2022 TAX RETURNS

If you received federal, provincial, or territorial government COVID-19 benefit payments, such as the Canada Recovery Benefit (CRB), Canada Recovery Caregiving Benefit (CRCB), Canada Recovery Sickness Benefit (CRSB) or Canada Worker Lockdown Benefit (CWLB), you will receive a T4A slip with instructions on how to report these amounts on your return. These slips are also available in My Account for Individuals.

If your income was tax exempt - If your CRB, CRCB, CRSB, or CWLB income is eligible for tax exemption under section 87 of the Indian Act, complete Form T90, Income Exempt from Tax under the Indian Act, and file your 2022 Income Tax and Benefit Return or simplified return to claim the tax withheld on your CRB, CRCB, CRSB and CWLB payments. For more information about taxes and benefits for Indigenous peoples, go to Taxes and benefits for Indigenous peoples. Request to deduct federal COVID-19 benefits repayment in a prior year.

Air quality improvement tax credit - If you were self-employed or a member of a partnership in 2022, you may be eligible to claim a refundable tax credit equal to 25% of your total ventilation expenses to improve ventilation or air quality at your place of business. For more information, see line 47557.

Critical mineral exploration tax credit - The critical mineral exploration tax credit (CMETC) is a new 30% investment tax credit for the exploration of specified minerals. The CMETC will only apply to expenditures renounced under eligible flow-through share agreements entered into after April 7, 2022 and before April 1, 2027. For more information and to claim this credit, see Form T2038(IND), Investment Tax Credit (Individuals).

Disability tax credit - For 2021 and later tax years, an individual diagnosed with type 1 diabetes is deemed to have met the two times and 14 hours per week requirements for life-sustaining therapy. For more information, see Guide RC4064, Disability-Related Information, or go to Tax credits and deductions for persons with disabilities.

First-time home buyers' tax credit - The amount used to calculate the first-time home buyers' tax credit has increased to \$10,000 for a qualifying home purchased after December 31, 2021. **Home accessibility tax credit -** The annual expense limit of the home accessibility tax credit has increased to \$20,000. Labour mobility deduction for tradespeople.

BEWARE OF TAX SCAMS - This is the time of year when scammers try to get you to give them information so they can steal your return. CRA does NOT request information over the phone and does not ask you to purchase Gift Cards. Don't fall for requests to pay out money or face prosecution.



March Is Fraud Awareness Month

Scammers are working every day to try and scam you out of your money, especially with phone and internet scams. During Fraud Awareness Month, take a look at the common scams trying to get you to part with your money.

TAX SCAMS - CRA will never request personal information over the phone or via email. Never give out social insurance numbers, bank account numbers and **NEVER** send money or gift cards even if the scammers try to pressure you that you will face arrest for not complying.

CRYPTO SCAMS - Canadians are being scammed out of record-breaking dollar amounts via cryptocurrency investment fraud. According to the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre, Canadians reported losses of \$308.6M to investment fraud in 2022 compared to \$164M in 2021. Of those reports, many involved Canadians investing in cryptocurrency after seeing a deceptive ad.

DELIVERY SCAMS - I seem to be getting a lot of fake emails purporting to be from Fedex, UPS or Amazon advising me there is a problem with an item I have purchased. Be careful of this one as the scammer is trying to get your personal information. Check with your carrier/purchaser to see if there is a problem before you answer any email.

CHARITY SCAMS - A lot of groups and orgainzatins raise funds via the internet. Always check with the group, do some investigation before you donate. You may go to the website and it looks legitimate but really is fake and the scammers not only get your donation but have access to your credit card information.

FAKE BUSINESS SCAMS - If you run a small business, carefully watch your email. You may get a fake invoice for items you did not order or get a notice saying that your invoice payment is overdue. If you are in a hurry, you may think this is a legitimate invoice, always check.

INTERNET SECURITY SCAMS - You may click on a link and suddenly a notice pops up saying your computer is being hacked and you need to contact the security company (many times it is supposed to be MICROSOFT). It will tell you not to turn off your computer, do **NOT** click any further, turn your computer off and it will disappear.
