





# Take 2 OIRECTOR WITH Paul Power

When I first saw the trailer for Russell Crowe's latest movie, "The Pope's Exorcist" I was very keen to see it; it was later on that I realized it was about Father Gabriele Amorth. The director of 1973's "The Exorcist" (William Friedken) directed a Netflix documentary on the same priest in 2017. Amorth purportedly performed over 50,000 exorcisms in Italy since becoming an "official" exorcist in 1986. However, this priest was also known for claiming that Harry Potter books can lead towards the devil, and that yoga was satanic. He saw the devil in everythingand to be honest in the documentary he comes across as one creepy and (in my opinion) truly evil person. The opposite can be said here about Russell Crowe. How much of this movie is factual no one knows, but Crowe brings a hard-nosed intensity to the role as Father Amorth: Crowe is charismatic, funny and likes a little nip now and then. In the film he is called out to a very disturbing 'possession' at an old abbey in Spain. What happens next is a



spine-tingling ride for the viewer. The horror effects are very imaginative, and a nice break from the usual 'gore porn' often seen nowadays in the horror film genre. Also, there's an incredible revelation about the Spanish Inquisition later on in the movie that was mind blowing. The movie "Gladiator" is one of my top 2 favourite movies of all time-and Crowe became a cinematic icon because of it. He was also amazing as the over-the-top road rage driver in the movie "Unhinged", as well as dozens of other top notch films. Russell Crowe's presentation here is the polar opposite of the real Father Amorth, but Crowe breathes new life into the portrayal of a very, very dark subject. This is a movie well worth watching.

Goodman's first recordings were made with the Pollack group in 1926, and give a strong example of Benny's influences at the time. During this period Goodman recorded his first sides as a leader with members of the Pollack band.

### **Grocery Rebate Coming July 5th**

The Grocery Rebate, intended to offset the rising cost of groceries, has been granted royal assent, promising to grant eligible single Canadians up to \$234 and families up to \$467. Seniors are eligible for up to \$225.

It takes the form of a supplement to the January 2023 GST credit payment (which is based on 2021 tax returns), up to those \$234, \$467 and \$225 maximums. So only GST credit-eligible residents are eligible for the Grocery Rebate.



# - TAX TIPS 2022 - SPECIALIZED MEDICAL CARE

If you or a loved one needed specialized medical care during the year (like palliative care or another health-related expense), you might have some additional medical expenses that others don't. The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) and Revenu Québec offer some relief by using the cost of your eligible medical expenses to lower the taxes you owe. The more you claim, the more you'll get from your return.

commonly missed medical expenses - When it comes to claiming medical expenses, there's a long list of the potential expenses you can claim. You might be eligible to claim the cost of expenses such as hearing aids, insulin, and diabetic supplies. Depending on your situation, you might also be able to claim lesser-known expenses like marijuana (if you had a prescription).

#### I WANT TO CLAIM MEDICAL MARIJUANA ON MY RETURN

— what should I know? - If you wanted to claim the cost of medical marijuana on your return, you'll need a prescription from an approved medical practitioner (like your doctor) and you'll need to make sure you bought your cannabis from a licensed producer (keep your receipts!).

**SPECIALIZED MEDICAL CARE -** Specialized medical care refers to medical expenses that have a specific or specialized component to it. This might include people who need individual therapy plans or treatments, or even those who need assistance from someone with specific training.

### WHAT ARE SOME EXAMPLES OF SPECIALIZED MEDICAL

CARE? - Common examples of specialized medical care include:

Personal therapy plans: - You can claim the cost of their personal therapy plans, such as one created by psychologists, physiotherapists, acupuncturists, chiropractor, etc. as specialized medical care if they meet certain eligibility criteria

**SERVICE ANIMALS -** You can claim the cost of purchasing and caring for (including the cost of buying food and veterinarian care) a specially trained service animal if: You're blind, You're profoundly deaf, You have a severe and prolonged physical impairment that restricts the use of your arms or legs; You're autistic; You're epileptic; or You're affected by severe diabetes.
