

I was glad to hear aboutand eventually watch the third season of the amazing comedy "Party Down". For those of you not familiar with this show it follows a motley crew of aspiring actors, writers and others who work in the catering business to make ends meet while they wait for their 'big break". The thing about this series is that the first season aired in 2009, then was canceled after the second season in 2010 due to low ratings, plus the fact that 2 of the main characters left to sign on to "Parks and Recreation" (Jane lynch and Adam Scott). Tommy and his brother Jimmy worked in several bands (including those of Rudy Vallee, Vincent Lopez, and especially Paul Whiteman) before forming the original Dorsey Brothers Orchestra in 1934.
