

I often check Atlantic Music's Facebook page to see what's up and coming in Newfoundland's music scene, eventually writing reviews on many of their artists. That led me to Evelvn Jess, her YouTube channel, and this, Evelvn's debut CD "Bare Bones". According to her online bio; "Evelyn Jess is an openly female singergay, songwriter from the outport town of Ragged Harbour, Newfoundland. Growing up singing in church choirs and Lions Clubs, she dreamed of bigger stages and brighter lights. Currently residing in Conception Bay South, NL, Jess has developed a style that is easy listening, while tackling big ideas and challenging norms. Her quirky, heartfelt songs cover everything from her struggles with mental health to the disappearance of the Canadian penny". To me that word "quirky" can also mean refreshingly original-as is the case here. The album opens with the hauntingly beautiful song "Trepassey In June" and as one hears the lyrics one realizes that it's about Amelia Earhart's time in Newfoundland before her historic trans-Atlan-



tic flight in 1928. Without mentioning every song I'll just say that "Bare Bones" starts off subtly, and then builds to a more uptempo and personal number where Evelvn's vocals remind me of a mix of Gwen Stefani and Melissa Etheridge, and "Home To Newfoundland" will tug at the heartstrings around here with the lyrics "the kettle on the stove" and "feet in the sand". Continuing on, the song "Waves" is a reflection on what could have been, and what now is. It's a very strong messageand "One Big Mess" is a midtempo ode to that special one. The album closes off with "Cape Cod By The Sea", and this one will strike a chord with all of us who think back to their younger days, and the importance of family and home-and how we long for days gone by. - TAX TIPS 2022 -

SELF-EMPLOYED TAX DEDUCTIONS

You might be self-employed if:

You're a freelancer, independent contractor, or gig worker; or You have a side hustle (like selling handmade candles on Etsy or running a local dog-walking service).

If you're self-employed, you'll need to report your business income on your personal income tax return using the Statement of business or professional activities (T2125 and TP-80).

DEDUCT YOUR BUSINESS EXPENSES - You might be able to claim some of your business expenses to reduce the taxes you owe. Keep in mind, these expenses must be work-related – you won't be able to claim personal expenses. Here are some common types of expenses that you can claim on the Statement of business or professional activities (T2125 and TP-80):

SUPPLIES - You can deduct the cost of items your business used to provide goods or services. For example, if you run a plumbing business, you can deduct the cost of cleaning supplies. You can also deduct the cost of office supplies, such as pens, paper, staplers, and more.

However, you can't deduct the cost of personal supplies or services. For example, you can't claim the cost of dry cleaning or hair styling products that you used for yourself, even if you needed to look presentable for your business.

VEHICLES - If you have a company car, or use your personal vehicle for work, you can claim some of the costs you paid to maintain it, such as:

Fuel; Repairs and routine maintenance;

Insurance; and License and registration fees.

Make sure you keep your receipts and keep a record of the kilometers you drive for work-related reasons (since you can't claim the kilometers you drive for personal reasons). You'll need these details in order to deduct your expenses.

TRAVEL - If you travelled for work, you might be able to deduct the costs for flights, ground transportation, hotels, and 50% of what you paid for meals.

HOME OFFICE - If you run your business from home, even if it was for the first time this year, you can deduct your home office expenses. Eligible home office expenses might include:

Home Internet access fees, some of the rent or mortgage interest you paid for your home; and Utilities such as electricity and heat. The amount you can claim depends how much of your home is used for your business. For example, let's say your home has 4 rooms and one of them is your office. If you want to claim your rent and utilities, you can claim 25% of these costs!
