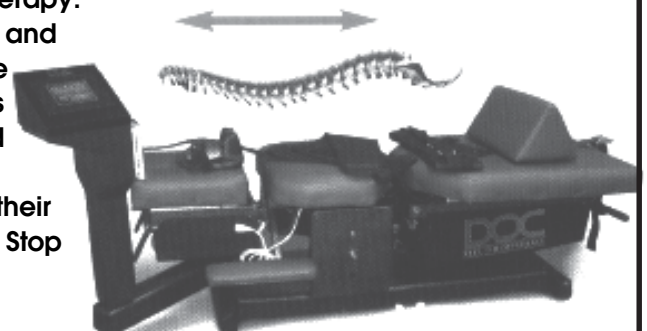

Halloween is almost here so let's get spooked; "The Nun II" is the sequel to the highly successful 2018 film; both are part of "The Conjuring Universe" franchise and thus, there was a lot of anticipation for this release. In short, the story sees the return of Taissa Farmiga, Jonas Bloquet and Bonnie Aarons in their roles as good nun, helping hand and demon nun, respectively. After a horrific death of a priest in France, the good nun and a novice nun travel to the church-and then to a monastery turned winery turned boarding school to face off against the demon Valak (a former angel cast out by God). I will say that the locations and sets for this movie look really good, the acting is decent and the special effects and action sequences are fairly well-done, but I just felt like I was watching a 'Nancy Drew goes to Hell' kind of film. Don't get me wrong, I think "Stranger Things" is one of the best blasts of fresh air we've had in a while, and



many productions aimed at young adults are very entertaining; this ain't one of them. Online reviews range from good to well, not so good; Mark Kennedy of the Associated Press gave it 1/5 stars, writing, "A new directing and writing team fails to shock or scare with a color-by-numbers plot and a meandering, languid wannabe frightfest." Ed Pottton of the British Times gave the film 3/5 stars, saying it "often flirts with ridiculousness", but praised Michael Chaves's direction, Farmiga and Downey's performances and the ending. I think they pretty much summed it all up, so I would suggest skipping this to watch some old-school masterpiece horror films from the 1960's and 1970's. If they were scary enough for Black Sabbath they're good enough for me. Boo!

NOVA SCOTIA HEATING GRANT

Apply for a heating assistance rebate: Heating Assistance Rebate Program.

The Heating Assistance Rebate Program helps low-and moderate-income Nova Scotians with the cost of home heating. Rebates are \$600 for each household.

Apply to the Heating Assistance Rebate Program for help with the cost of home heating. Rebate amount - You can receive \$600 if you qualify for the Heating Assistance Rebate Program.

To qualify for the rebate, you need to pay for your own home (residential) heat and meet 1 of the following criteria:

- have a 2022 net income of \$55,000 or less and live alone with no kids or dependents

- have a combined 2022 net household income of \$75,000 or less and live with kids, dependents or other adults

- receive Income Assistance from the Department of Community Services

- receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) or the Allowance from Service Canada

If your personal or financial situation has changed since last year, you still may qualify. Examples of changes include becoming widowed, getting divorced or legally separated, losing your job, turning 18, recently arriving in Canada, or having the custody of your children change.

Contact the Department of Service Nova Scotia and Internal Services to find out if you qualify.

You need to apply by 31 March 2024.

SENIORS CARE GRANT REGISTERING NOW

The Seniors Care Grant helps low-income seniors with the cost of household services (like lawn care, snow removal, grocery delivery, transportation, small home repairs and phone service), healthcare services (like physiotherapy and mental health support) and home heating.

Grants are \$750 for each household. You can apply until 31 March 2024. To qualify for the grant, you need to be 65 or older by 31 March 2024 and meet all of the following criteria - have a household net income of \$37,500 or less, live in your own home or apartment, have your name on the property title, Land Titles Initiative Certificate of Claim or residential lease agreement or a Band administrative letter issued by a First Nation community (reserve) - have paid (or that you will pay) for household and healthcare services and home heating between 1 April 2023 and 31 March 2024 - Apply online or - Phone: 902-424-5200

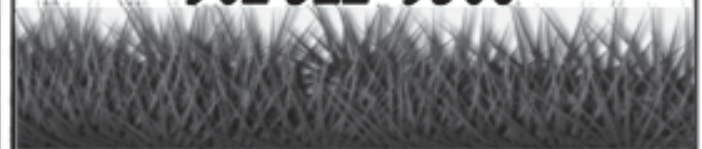
