## Take 2

### PAUL POWER

When Alice Cooper releases a new album I always feel compelled to write about it; my very first published column was back in 2003 for Halifax's "Soundcheck" magazine, and it was for an Alice Cooper album-plus I saw him perform live way back in the day in Sydney, and followed his career for longer than I care to mention. Alice is back with this his new solo album number 22, "Road". What's so special about this album is that Alice and his band recorded it live in the studio-with no overdubs, and that takes guts but Alice said he wanted people to hear just how good this band is. This is sort of a concept album about being on the the rock and roll road: the stage, the audience, the groupies, the alcohol and drugs, and the loneliness-as in the song "Welcome To The Show". The first release was actually "I'm Alice" and as expected it's autobiographical on Vincent Furnier's alter-ego. Next up was "White Line Frankenstein"



which is a rocking hot track about riding the white line from city to city. A real surprise is the boogie-woogie charged vibe of "Rules Of The Road", guaranteed to keep toes tapping. Alice has some great rules spelled out in this number. A lot of what makes this album so good is the return of Bob Ezrin-the man who produced 16 of Alice Cooper's best and most memorable albums. Maybe that's why "100 More Miles" and "Dead Don't Dance" sound like some of Alice's earlier, more ghoulish tunes. "Welcome To My Nightmare" era. The one ballad here is the excellent "Baby Please Don't Go", but this one's from the perspective of a rock star's wife as he faces another road tour. A great cover of The Who's "Magic Bus" closes out this, another great Alice Cooper album.

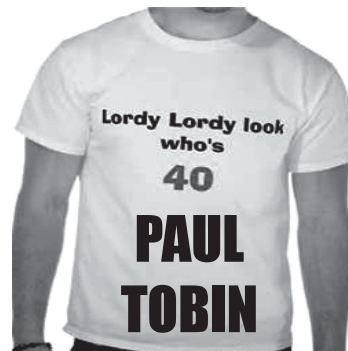

## Parkinson Canada Superwalk Set for Sunday Our Lady of Fatima Parish Hall, Sydney River

It started as an occasional twitch in his right pinky finger – the first sign that something wasn't right with Brett LeBlanc.

A few months later, after an initial visit to his family doctor and then several with neurologist Dr. Mandat Maharaj, which included a battery of tests, the Florence native received a life-altering diagnosis.

"It was Parkinson's," he said. In his early 50s, LeBlanc was operating a business, caring for his beloved aging mother – Shirley – and now dealing with a neurological disorder, one that kills the dopamine (a chemical that controls movement) cells in the brain, which triggers a variety of symptoms.

The pinky shake, before long, became an uncontrollable tremor in his right arm; one that not only made something as mundane as buttoning a shirt virtually impossible, but also exhausting. The adverse effects, which were worsening with each day, included muscle rigidity and weakness.

"I felt like I was drowning," LeBlanc remembered, noting that the mentally and physically exhausting tremor had made its way into his left arm.

Increasingly depressed – another result of Parkinson's – his sense of hope continued to plummet. But, when things were probably at their worst in early 2017, he was thrown a life preserver; one that came in the form of neurologist Dr. Lutz Weise and the neuromodulation team at the QEII Health Sciences Centre in Halifax.

Weise, who had recently moved his practice to Nova Scotia's capital city from his native Germany, performed deep brain stimulation (DBS) surgeries. It was an option LeBlanc had explored but – up until then – there were no surgeons offering that option east of Montreal. The neurologist who performed DBS in Halifax had left a few years earlier.

Essentially, DBS provides a pacemaker for the brain, one aimed at stopping the uncontrollable tremors. Although there is never a guarantee it will work – or at what level – it did the trick for LeBlanc. Almost instantly it seemed, the tremors were gone; his quality of life restored.

"Although it has been a life saver for me, I know it is not a cure," LeBlanc noted.

The crippling fatigue, muscle rigidity and leg weakness remain daily occurrences, with falls still commonplace. And now, the most recent – and increasingly frustrating – effect is his voice becoming nothing but a whisper.

LeBlanc's Parkinson's journey is just one of many being taken by residents of Cape Breton, along with their caregivers, family and friends; some of those wins – and losses – will be shared and celebrated this weekend on the grounds of Our Lady of Fatima Parish in Sydney River.

The annual Parkinson Canada Superwalk for the region will take place Sunday, Sept. 10.

Check-in gets underway at 11:30 a.m., with the walk scheduled for 2:00 p.m.

Everyone is welcome to come out and enjoy plenty of music, food and fun in support of the worthy cause.
