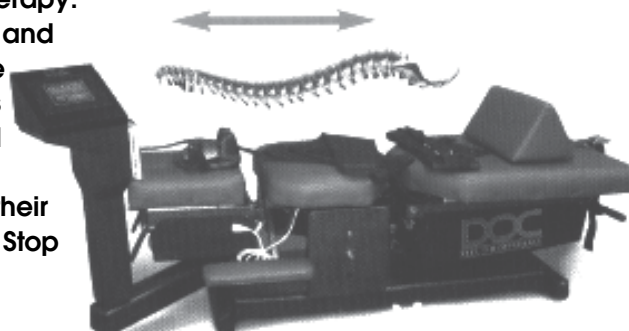

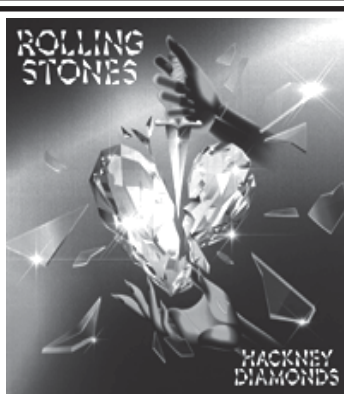

PAUL POWER

When I first heard about this album I wasn't expecting a lot because I didn't really like the band's 2015 all Blues covers album-but this one, "Hackney Diamonds", has the first original stuff we're heard from the Rolling Stones since 2005. Unfortunately it's also the first album released after Charlie Watts passed away. He did however play on the songs "Mess It Up" and "Live By The Sword" before his passing. So, what's the verdict on this album? It's really, really good. Things blast off with "Angry", a song that sounds like The Clash-with jangling guitars and a kicking beat (thanks to drummer Steve Jordan). As a matter of fact the band sounds like they took a time machine back to the early 1980's when they helped define the rock and roll of that era: the ridiculously good "Bite My Head Off" and "Whole Wide World" drive that vibe 100%. It's great to hear Keith Richards taking lead vocals on "Tell Me Straight", a somber song that would suit Bruce Springsteen



well, and it's also great to hear when the band keeps it's blues-oriented roots on "Depending On You" and "Sweet Sounds Of Heaven" (which really didn't need Lady Gaga or Stevie Wonder's guest appearance on the song-no offense to them). Other standout tracks are "Get Close" and "Mess It Up". The cover of Muddy Water's "Rolling Stone Blues" is such a great, and appropriate, closing tune. Mick Jagger told Jimmy Fallon that the album title was "a type of slang, it's like when you get your windscreen broken on Saturday night in Hackney, and all the bits go on the street... that's 'Hackney Diamonds'." Given that Mick Jagger is 80, Ronnie Woods is 76 and Keith Richards is 147 (no, really he's 79) this album shows no sign of age-just an amazing band reclaiming their importance in a world filled with crappy music. Rock on!

NOVA SCOTIA HEATING GRANT

Apply for a heating assistance rebate: Heating Assistance Rebate Program.

The Heating Assistance Rebate Program helps low-and moderate-income Nova Scotians with the cost of home heating. Rebates are \$600 for each household.

Apply to the Heating Assistance Rebate Program for help with the cost of home heating. Rebate amount - You can receive \$600 if you qualify for the Heating Assistance Rebate Program.

To qualify for the rebate, you need to pay for your own home (residential) heat and meet 1 of the following criteria:

- have a 2022 net income of \$55,000 or less and live alone with no kids or dependents

- have a combined 2022 net household income of \$75,000 or less and live with kids, dependents or other adults

- receive Income Assistance from the Department of Community Services

- receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) or the Allowance from Service Canada

If your personal or financial situation has changed since last year, you still may qualify. Examples of changes include becoming widowed, getting divorced or legally separated, losing your job, turning 18, recently arriving in Canada, or having the custody of your children change.

Contact the Department of Service Nova Scotia and Internal Services to find out if you qualify.

You need to apply by 31 March 2024.

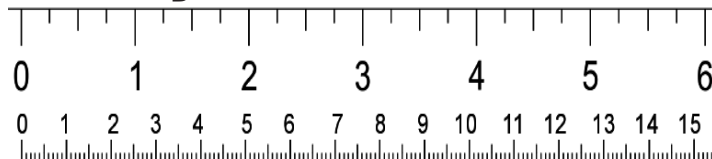

How Many inches of Snow Did We Get ?



Many of you still do not understand the Metric System
and are unsure of how to convert centimeters into inches.
We have been asked by several of our readers to help
them understand how snow is measured and how to
convert it to inches.

The official conversion is 2.54 centimeters equates to
1 inch. If you view the ruler illustration above you can see
10 centimeters of snow would equal approximately
4 inches and 15 centimeters of snow would be just under
6 inches.

If the snow gets higher as in some storms we are bound
to get, just double the figures above - for example, 30
centimeters of snow would equal approximately 1 foot of
snow. After that amount, it doesn't matter, you aren't
going anywhere soon.

Times were tough in 1983 as Christmas approached. Booger Phillips and Teddy Coffin were out of work and were looking for a way to earn extra money. They hit upon what they thought was a novel way to get the extra cash.

They figured that Christmas trees were selling for \$35.00 and \$45.00 down the "Boston States" so they decided to rent a truck, cut about 100 trees and sell them down in the U.S. They estimated that with the money they had to put out for the trees and truck rental, they would clear about \$1,000 each by Christmas. The American dollar was about 30% at that time so this was an extra incentive.

They rented a stake body truck from a neighbour for \$250.00 and they already had chain saws and axes for trimming the trees. They went out to the Gabarus area and by December 7th, they had their 100 trees and headed for Boston. By the time they hit Amherst, the truck was acting up and they had to take it to a garage for a new fuel pump. That wasn't too bad, only \$75.00.

They decided to sleep in the truck to save on hotel money. That was fine as long as the truck was running and the heater was on. They nearly froze the first night but labored on and by early morning they hit the American border in Calais. The Customs officer asked them if they had their import paperwork. The two looked at one another in puzzlement. They had to park and wait almost 5 hours before somebody showed up and examined their cargo. They had to pay a \$125.00 import fee.

The officer asked them if they had a selling permit as they would need this when they got to Boston. The boys figured they would sell their trees quickly so they wouldn't need one. They finally arrived in Dedham where they knew a lot of ex-Cape Bretoners lived. They set up in a mall but after about two hours, the cops showed up and asked them for their selling permit. They didn't have one so down to the station they go and another \$60 was gone.

They didn't have too much success with the regular American customers. The boys figured they would lose what little money they had and were wondering if they made a big mistake. But then, a wonderful thing happened. A passerby spotted the truck and noticed the Nova Scotia plates. He chatted the boys up and they told them of their plan to earn Christmas money. The passerby was a Cape Bretoner from Judique and he was thrilled to have a real Cape Breton tree for Christmas.

He told the boys he would call all his friends and fellow Cape Bretoners when he got home. Within an hour, the parking lot was jammed with Cape Bretoners and the boys sold out all their trees. Many of the Capers exchanged the usual gossip and "do you know" questions. They were asked if they would be back next year and the boys said they would be there the same time.

So, their plan worked but not because of the American market but because so many Cape Bretoners loved the idea. The next year the boys had their own truck and started to bring other items like woolen socks and mitts, a few sweaters, cookies, apple and blueberry pies and small craft items that they sold on consignment. Once they sent their notice to their Judique friend that they would be there on a given day, the parking lot would be filled as the boys pulled in.

The manager of the mini mall was so pleased with the increased traffic that he didn't charge them any rental. They still go down each year and their fame has spread. They now carry CDs, pictures, tapes, books, baked goods and, of course, the Cape Breton trees which started it all.

SENIORS CARE GRANT REGISTERING NOW

The Seniors Care Grant helps low-income seniors with the cost of household services (like lawn care, snow removal, grocery delivery, transportation, small home repairs and phone service), healthcare services (like physiotherapy and mental health support) and home heating.

Grants are \$750 for each household. You can apply until 31 March 2024. To qualify for the grant, you need to be 65 or older by 31 March 2024 and meet all of the following criteria - have a household net income of \$37,500 or less, live in your own home or apartment, have your name on the property title, residential lease agreement - have paid (or that you will pay) for household and healthcare services and home heating between 1 April 2023 and 31 March 2024 - Apply online or - Phone: 902-424-5200
