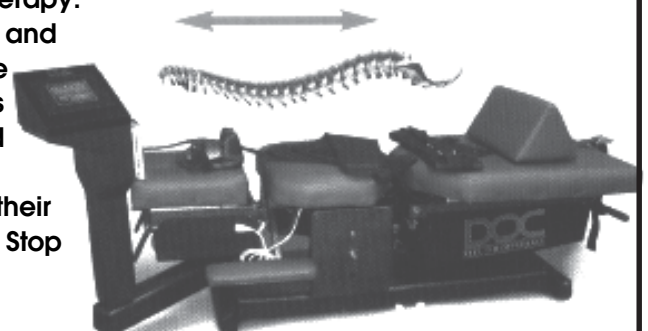

### PAUL POWER

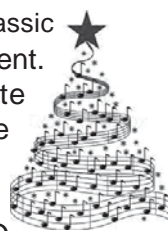
Before Ed Sheeran there was James Blunt. I mention that for a number of reasons; they are friends, Ed is godfather to one of James's sons, Ed and James did some amazing performances together and this album, "Who We Used to Be", sounds so much like an Ed Sheeran album that you might be tempted to re-read who's name is on the cover. Not saying that Blunt is copying Sheeran, because Blunt released Sheeran-like songs almost a decade before Ed. There's a nice balanced tempo of songs here; some are dance numbers and some will elicit a tear or two (remember James's "Monsters" music video?) and that happens most with the beautiful song "The Girl That Never Was". It's about his wife's miscarriage, and imagining what could have been having picked out a baby name and knowing the sex. For me the best songs here are the amazing dance-oriented "Some Kind Of Beautiful" and "Beside You". That EDM vibe continues on "Cold Shoul-

der" and "I Won't Die With You" (which sounds so much like Ed Sheeran that's it's eerie). James wrote the song "Dark Thought" about visiting his friend Carrie Fisher's house after she had passed away. They met in England in 2003, and he lived in Fisher's house in Los Angeles after he moved there to record "Back to Bedlam" in 2004. Carrie had spoken before on how close they became, and she was godmother to James's oldest son. The band Keane gets a sonic nod on the great song "All The Love That I Ever Needed" and "Glow" shadows Mr. Sheeran 100%. On the deluxe version of this album there are 4 extra tracks-and the last one, "When You're Gone", is phenomenal. This is an album that once again lets us hear just how awesome James Blunt really is.

Rebate Program. The Heating Assistance Rebate Program helps  
low-and moderate-income Nova Scotians with the cost of home  
heating. Rebates are \$600 for each household. Apply to the Heating  
Assistance Rebate Program for help with the cost of home  
heating. Rebate amount - You can receive \$600 if you qualify for  
the Heating Assistance Rebate Program.

To qualify for the rebate, you need to pay for your own home  
(residential) heat and meet **1** of the following criteria:

have a 2022 net income of \$55,000 or less and live alone with  
no kids or dependents

have a combined 2022 net household income of \$75,000 or  
less and live with kids, dependents or other adults

receive Income Assistance from the Department of Commu-  
nity Services

receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) or the  
Allowance from Service Canada

If your personal or financial situation has changed since last  
year, you still may qualify. Examples of changes include becom-  
ing widowed, getting divorced or legally separated, losing your  
job, turning 18, recently arriving in Canada, or having the custody  
of your children change. Contact the Department of Service Nova  
Scotia and Internal Services to find out if you qualify.

## Angela Iannetti Album Release Party

I would like to send out a great big thank you for all of the people who came out in that nasty weather last Saturday night for our opening night Album Release, and Cape Breton Christmas Dinner Party. Every year I have a Cape Breton Christmas Dinner Party, where I cook up a storm of authentic Italian foods, salads, pastas, meats, poultry and desserts. This year, our dinner party had a little twist, as I released my new Album, "Below The Tracks". For the last two years, I have been working very hard on pulling this eclectic album together, a mix of eight original songs, seven genres, recorded in three amazing studios. I recorded five of the songs in two studios in Halifax, R&B Recording Studio, and Iannetti Recording Studio, and last but not least, my last three songs in Nashville, with Jake Clayton Recording Studios. I finished in the Top 5 for thousands of American songwriters in an Audacy songwriting contest.

At sixty, I decided to record my very first Album, titled "Full Circle, which to my amazement took three Music Nova Scotia Nominations, and a year later I was honoured to open for Music Nova Scotia at the Host Hotel, Sydney Holiday Inn. I hadn't done anything professional prior to sixty for lack of confidence and fear of failure. I guess at sixty, with all of my imperfections, I thought, what if I do fail, at least I attempted to follow my dream, and no regrets...

I have performed in many events over the last three years, many which have raised money for our Community, such The Hospital Foundation, The Food Banks, and Heritage Festivals. CBC, CTV, CJOE, The Coast, Salt-wire, This Week, K-Lee Radio, and The Hawk have all been amazing in sharing my music, and my story, for which I am very grateful, and truly feel blessed.

I have travelled to Nashville on two occasions now, and I had the privilege of performing with some of Nashville's greatest singer song writers in Song Writers Circles, and I will be returning in the first of the New Year to perform. I have been so very fortunate to have so many to help me along my journey, teaching me the ropes, and giving me support.

I must tell you, the music industry is not easy, and putting an album together is work, but despite it all, it is my labor of love....

## SENIORS CARE GRANT REGISTERING NOW

The Seniors Care Grant helps low-income seniors with the cost of household services (like lawn care, snow removal, grocery delivery, transportation, small home repairs and phone service), healthcare services (like physiotherapy and mental health support) and home heating.
