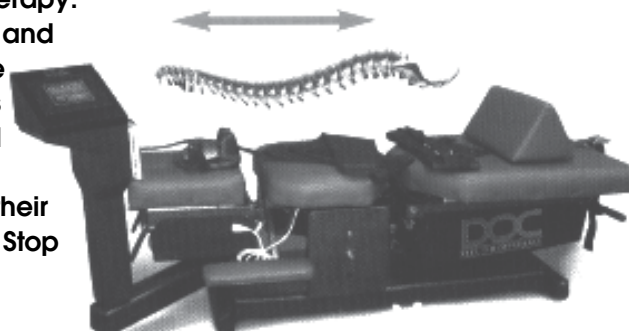

PAUL POWER

The folk duo of Ian & Sylvia (Tyson) were an important part of Canada's musical heritage, and peers with the likes of Gordon Lightfoot, Bob Dylan and more. Sadly, Ian passed away last December at 89 years of age, but at 83 years of age Sylvia just released this new album; she said it will be her final one. "At The End Of The Day" (Stony Plain) is a collection of songs that reminisce about a life well-lived, taking the good with the bad, and hopefully passing wisdom on to those on their own journeys. To be honest Sylvia Tyson's vocals here are a bit delicate at times, but what she offers through the songs makes up for any technical limitations. All 12 numbers are so eloquent and touching, with "I Never Got Over You", "At The End Of The Day" and "Sweet Agony" as the best examples. The song "Generous Heart" was co-written with Shirley



Eikhard a number of years ago and Sylvia said that unfortunately Shirley passed away a week after Sylvia told her that the song was being recorded. Uptempo songs are here too with "Now Tell Me That You Got the Blues" and "Long Chain Of Love"-both are like something that Rita MacNeil might have sung, and the Celtic influenced "Janet's Garden" is a nice way to close out the album. Besides her time spent performing/recording with husband Ian, Sylvia wrote the legendary song "You Were On My Mind", as well as numbers recorded by Crystal Gayle and Nana Mouskouri. The fact that at her age Sylvia could release an album that's filled with so many wonderful songs that come from the heart is the best reason to check this offering out.

NOVA SCOTIA HEATING GRANT

Apply for a heating assistance rebate: Heating Assistance Rebate Program.

The Heating Assistance Rebate Program helps low-and moderate-income Nova Scotians with the cost of home heating. Rebates are \$600 for each household.

Apply to the Heating Assistance Rebate Program for help with the cost of home heating. Rebate amount - You can receive \$600 if you qualify for the Heating Assistance Rebate Program.

To qualify for the rebate, you need to pay for your own home (residential) heat and meet 1 of the following criteria:

have a 2022 net income of \$55,000 or less and live alone with no kids or dependents

have a combined 2022 net household income of \$75,000 or less and live with kids, dependents or other adults

receive Income Assistance from the Department of Community Services

receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) or the Allowance from Service Canada

If your personal or financial situation has changed since last year, you still may qualify. Examples of changes include becoming widowed, getting divorced or legally separated, losing your job, turning 18, recently arriving in Canada, or having the custody of your children change.

Contact the Department of Service Nova Scotia and Internal Services to find out if you qualify.

You need to apply by 31 March 2024.

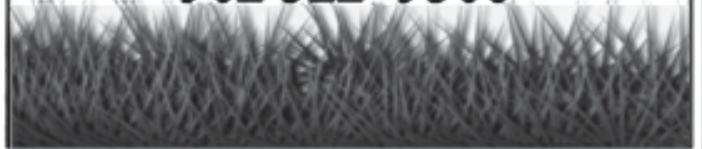
