





When Alice Cooper releases an album I always feel compelled to write about it; my very first published column was back in 2003 for Halifax's "Soundcheck" magazine, and it was for the latest Alice Cooper album. I also saw him perform live way back in the day in Sydney, and have followed his career for longer than I care to mention. This month marked the 50th anniversary of Cooper's "Billion Dollar Babies" release. The album was full of soon to be classic Cooper hits; "Hello Hurray", "Elected", "Billion Dollar Babies" and "No More Mr. Nice Guy" but par for the course as being rock and roll's number 1 shock rocker Alice also included "Sick Things", "I Love The Dead" and "Raped and Freezin" to name a few. Even by today's standards this record 'pushed the boat out' but imagine in 1974-Alice Cooper was like the Devils offspring. Ironically, Vincent Furnier (his real name) is the son of an evangelist. Irony and satire are 2 of



Alice's best musical weapons and his live performances included beheading, electrocution, caressed by real snakes, killer spiders and so much more. After the drugs and alcohol almost killed him Alice found a renewed and strong christian faith, and is credited with saving the lives of many musicians (their words) through support and counseling. The original album release was in a gate fold cover that looked like a snakeskin wallet, with a big 1 billion dollar bill included. Many well-known musicians have named this album as one of their all time favourites, and it has sold in the millions so far. The re-release also has some extra ear candy included. With over 40 albums to his credit (band and solo ones) Alice Cooper is still a vital part of the Hard Rock/Heavy Metal world.

Whether you're a full-time employee, part time, seasonal or occasional, income earned should be reported to the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA). Your company is also informing the CRA of the money

they paid you through a form called the T4, which they'll also send to you around February for the previous year's earnings.

Beware Watching Solar Eclipse

On April 8, 2024, a once in a lifetime total solar eclipse will be visible across North America, and those living in southern Ontario, Quebec and Atlantic Canada will have some of the best views.

The eclipse will stretch from Mexico's west coast and across Texas and the Midwestern U.S. before finally being visible in Canada.


Depending on where you are, eclipse-watchers will have a clear view of the sun's corona, or atmosphere, which is usually hidden by the sun's brightness. The total eclipse can only be seen in North America, from Mexico to Newfoundland, for about an hour and a half.

NASA says "a total solar eclipse happens when the moon passes between the sun and Earth, completely blocking the face of the sun."

According to the space agency, the shadow the total eclipse creates as it moves across the earth is called the path of totality, which can stretch between 100 and 115 kilometres wide. Those watching the eclipse outside of the path of totality will be able to see a partial eclipse—when the moon blocks out some of the sun's light—but they won't get to see the total eclipse.

SAFETY TIPS - Looking directly at the eclipse, without the proper eye protection, could potentially lead to permanent dam-

age or possibly even blindness," said Léger. "Do not look at the sun without using proper certified eye protection eclipse glasses, or else you could risk damaging your vision."



People are advised to use certified solar eclipse glasses in accordance with ISO 12312-2:2015 and follow the directions that come with this special eyewear, said Léger.

"Young people and dependant adults should be supervised if they plan to use these special glasses to ensure they are using them properly," said Léger. "It is important everybody understands that wearing regular sunglasses, or using your phone or an unfiltered camera, will not be good enough, and could be unsafe."

The Canadian Association of Optometrists website has additional safety information and a link to a list of reputable vendors for certified solar eclipse glasses.

People are reminded there are other ways to view the eclipse safely, such as using a pinhole camera. Instructions on making one are available on the Canadian Space Agency website.

TAX TIPS & VALUABLE DEDUCTIONS

Tax Tips for Canadians over 65 - If you're in your golden years or taking care of a family member who is, take a minute to review what credits and deductions you could both be eligible for.

Make sure you file a tax return:

Always file, because you could be entitled to other credits, deductions and benefits that get triggered by your tax return such as GST/HST credits. If you're receiving Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) through Old Age Security, make sure to file on time to ensure their benefits continue uninterrupted.

INCOME SPLIT AND SAVE - You're allowed to split up to half of your eligible pension income with a spouse or common-law partner. Income splitting allows some seniors to enjoy a significant tax reduction. In the situation where the lower-income spouse has very little income, the tax savings are substantial. If your spouse is unable to completely offset his or her age amount, pension income and disability amount against tax payable, he or she may transfer the unused portion to your return.

SPLIT YOUR CPP AND SAVE - You may be able to split part of your CPP retirement benefits with your spouse depending on how long you lived together when you were contributing to the plan. This is an advantage if one senior is in a higher tax bracket than the other. However, to do so, you must apply to Human Resources & Social Development Canada using Form ISP-1002. It cannot be done at the time of tax preparation.

MEDICAL EXPENSES CAN ADD UP - A portion of most medical expenses can be claimed! Everything from medication to nursing home fees, and even medical insurance for a trip or wintering in another country is considered eligible. Medical expenses are reduced by a percentage of your income, so it is normally more beneficial for the lower income spouse to claim them. And if you had to travel to obtain medical treatment that was not available where you live, you may be able to claim the cost of transportation, meals and accommodation.

TAKING CARE OF A SENIOR HAS ITS TAX BENEFITS - If you are over 65 and dependent on your children or other family members because of an impairment in physical or medical functions, they may be able to claim the Canada Caregiver Tax Credit. To qualify for the tax credit, your earnings need to be less than \$23,906 in 2019 and a doctor needs to supply a note explaining the nature and duration of the impairment. If you are eligible for the disability tax credit, they may also be able to claim any portion that you do not need to reduce your taxes to zero.
