TAX TIP - Deduction for tools (tradespersons and apprentice mechanics) – Starting in 2023, the maximum employment deduction for tradespersons' eligible tools has increased from \$500 to \$1,000. If you have been filing your taxes on paper, make this the year you file online. We have a list of NETFILE-certified tax software products that are easy to use, fast, and secure, some of which are free! This software will walk you through the tax-filing process, including sending your tax return directly to the CRA. What's great is that you'll get immediate confirmation that we received your tax return.

With NETFILE, you may be able to use these secure services=

Auto-fill my return allows you to automatically fill in parts of your income tax and benefit return with information that the CRA has available at the time of the request. This service can retrieve information from the current year and seven years prior.

Express NOA allows you to view your notice of assessment (NOA) in your certified tax software and in My Account, immediately after the CRA receives and processes your return.

If you combine online filing with direct deposit, you could get any refund you're owed in as little as eight business days. Paper returns aren't as fast, and it could take up to eight weeks to process them.

Know what income to report - You might be receiving income from many different sources. Here's a list of some of the most common types of income you may start receiving when you retire or turn 65. If you need more information on what to report, check out our All types of income page.

Don't miss out on money! - When you file your income tax and benefit return, we determine your eligibility to receive these payments. Find out what you may be eligible for and how to apply on our Tax credits and benefits for individuals page.

You may also be eligible to receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS). It's a monthly payment available to Old Age Security pensioners who have low income and are living in Canada. If you already receive the GIS, by filing your income tax and benefit return on time, you avoid interruptions to your payments and you won't have to reapply.

You could also claim deductions, credits, and expenses, that you are eligible for, on your income tax and benefit return to reduce the amount of tax you have to pay. For example, you may be eligible to claim the Canada caregiver credit if you support your spouse or common-law partner with a physical or mental impairment. There's also the Disability tax credit (DTC). This credit helps reduce the income tax that people with physical or mental impairments, or their supporting family members, may have to pay.

The Northside Gals- An Active Northside Community Resource

Our organization has been active since November 2021. Our organization began by assisting with comfort centers during Hurricane Fiona. The team of partners gathered supplies and additional volunteers to provide meals, lunches/snacks for seniors and children, and social interaction.

This is the first year of operation of the Northside Gals. We began with 21 core members, and we have grown to over 50 members during the year. Our organization will continue to accept new members and volunteers who support our projects such as the new group "Men behind the Northside Gals". An African proverb stated "it takes a village to raise a child," we believe it takes a community to care for our most vulnerable especially those who are marginalized, living in poverty, seniors, youth, and children. In the spirit of community, we operate by partnering with the following groups and organizations including but not limited to: Holy Family Parish, Sydney Mines and North Sydney foodbanks, Northside Homemakers, Miner's Memorial Manor, Christmas Cheer, St. Vincent DePaul, Community Social Workers, Seton Community Youth Center, local churches, The Marthas Social Justice group, Diocese of Antigonish, Bereaved Families of Cape Breton, Community Cares, Sydney Mines, Knights of Columbus, Salvation Army, Souls Harbour Mission, J Street and Clifford Street Youth Centres, New Deal Development, Northside businesses, Northside fishers, Northside Firemen, Princess Credit Union, The Northside Boys, Northside the Lakes Community Health Board, and elected provincial, federal and municipal officials.

- 2) Our group voted on two names The Northside Gals and The Northern Lights. The chosen name was The Northside Gals. We are a group of women from the Northside, and we formed to support our local communities on the Northside.
- 3) Our activities are assisting seniors, families, and children in various ways; by providing hot meals, entertainment, arts and crafts, music, and socialization.

The Northside Gals Community Projects 2023 in one year of operation include: - 1514 Meals, 1074 Treat Bags, 200 Blessings Bags with school supplies, 100 Blessing Bags with T-shirts and supplies, 50 Gift Bags for seniors, Toys Donated by North Sydney Firemen and Brogan's Fisheries Toy Drive, Free Community Thanksgiving Meal (approximately 200 meals), Snacks for Clifford Street Youth Center, J Street Christmas Pizza Party, Jr. High School grading day lunch at Dukes (local restaurant), Raised garden beds for senior's complex, Coats for Kids donated by the Knights of Columbus, Kids pop up Christmas Shopping, Spring Pop up Kid's Shopping, Community Grading Day Party, Community Back to School Party, Community Halloween Party, Community Christmas Party and Bethlehem Walk, Adopt a Family: 18 Families adopted - \$7,807, Supported Memorial High School Culinary Class for specialty training - \$3,000, Memorial High School Safe Grad - \$3,000, Community Cares Youth Center - \$1,500, Sydney Mines Food Bank - \$1,000.

Our "Shining Lights Series" is a series of events that we host several times throughout the year. Each event focuses on a different community organization giving them the opportunity to present information about their organization to the audience in

attendance. The proceeds raised to attend the event, are given to the organization as a financial contribution to support their causes. The purpose is to raise community awareness of the poverty and social issues impacting our community. And the overall benefit for everyone is advocacy, net-working and relationship building.

Since then, our members have assisted seniors, families, and children in various ways: by providing hot meals and lunches for children; securing funds; and coordinating, organizing and executing various community events. Members have organized events which included food, arts and crafts activities, music, and various types of entertainment.
