

DWIGHT YOAKAM — "Under the Covers" - The other day I was scanning through my SiriusXM radio channels and as I passed through them I stopped on channel 60, "Outlaw Country". Now normally I would skip by this channel because of the "C" word (country) as I usually claim to not like country music-but to be honest I don't like 99% of the 'new country', which is basically pop music

with cowboy hats, but the old school country and western music, and outlaw country is really good.

The voice on SiriusXM was that of Dwight Yoakam, and the song was his cover of the Glen Campbell/

Jimmy Webb classic "Wichita Lineman". The original version has a lonely, haunting quality to it whereas Dwight's is more uptempo-but his voice is what totally sells the song, and the number was on Dwight's "Under the Covers" album: hard to believe that it was released 21 years ago, because the album sounds totally current today. It was Dwight's first album of all covers, and featured an amazing duet with Sheryl Crow on Sonny & Cher's "Baby Don't Go", a blues-laced approach to "Good Time Charlie's Got The Blues" by Danny O'Keefe, which was also covered by Willie Nelson, Elvis Presley, Waylon Jennings,

Charlie Rich, Conway Twitty and many more-it's a country standard for sure. There's also a great version of the 1960 hit song "North to Alaska" by Johnny Horton, a hot rocking take on The Beatles "Things We Said Today" and Dwight even does an amazing bluegrass cover of The Clash's "Train in Vain".

A lot of musicians do cover songs; the key to a good one is to add their own flair to the song, or do a new and fresh delivery on the track-Dwight did

that with every song on this album, none moreso than "Here Comes The Night" by Van Morrison's band Them. Canada's own Streetheart had a hit with the song in 1979. Honourable mention also goes

out to "The Last Time" (Rolling Stones) as Dwight hits the ball out of the park for a musical home run.

Dwight has sold over 25 million albums, is a movie actor of some renown (Sling Blade, Wedding Panic Room, Crashers, etc.) and his pioneering style of "Bakersfield" country music was so good that Johnny Cash claimed Dwight as his favourite country singer-so when The Man In Black endorses you, you know you're something uniqueand to that end. Time magazine called Dwiaht "Renaissance Man". Just by chance a satellite radio station opened a door for me to a phenomenal album.

TAX TIPS 2017

Last Minute Income Tax Deadlines

The Personal Tax Return deadline has passed, but it's not too late to file! Personal Tax Returns for 2017 should have been filed by Monday, April 30, 2018. Selfemployed must file by Friday, June 15, 2018, but any tax owing must be paid by April 30th to avoid interest charges.

If you are Efiling online, Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) sometimes allows a grace period for taxpayers who may experience delays in submitting their return online. Any amount owing is still expected to be paid by April 30th (normally) to avoid any penalties.

There were transmission errors occurring on April 30th due to the large volume of returns that were being filed on the last day, and may returns had to be submitted 2-3 times before they were transmitted.

Even if you have not filed your 2017 return yet, you still can! Most registered Efilers still transmit tax returns after the deadline, and some throughout the entire year.

Be aware though, that some charge a premium if you are filing late, so be aware of the cost of filing before you file.

The CRA will accept personal tax filing up to 10 years backwards, so if you have not had your personal taxes filed in more than one of the preceeding eyars, you can still have that done and get caught up.

Speak to a professional tax preparer about your options and whether filing under a penalty relief program might be an option for you.


