



Tomb Raider - Sometimes movie reboots work, sometimes they don't. In this case it worked out wonderfully. Not only is this "Tomb Raider" a great movie, it is infinitely better than the 2001 and 2003 films starring Angelina Jolie. In this case Lara Croft (played by Swedish actor Alicia

Vikander) is much more likeable, and more believable than Jolie's portrayal of the same character, which at the best of times was basically flat, cold and 2 dimensionalthe best com

parison I can think of is that Jolie

played the game version of Lara Croft-whereas Alicia Vikander plays a three-dimensional female version of Indian Jones, and that is a great comparison because this movie is very much like an Indiana Jones flick. The sets and locations are amazing. and without giving too much of the plot away the storyline is believable, and outright creepy.

The film starts off with a voiceover by Lord Richard Croft (Dominic West) as he details the legend of an ancient Japanese sorceress named Himiko. It was said that she held power over life and death, and one touch from her was enough to kill anyone. Her war generals overthrew her and buried her

body on the island of Yamatai, to prevent her evil from spreading. Lord Croft wanted to learn more about Himiko's dark secrets, but was reluctant to leave his daughter behindwhich of course he ultimately had to do as she was still in her early teens at the time, and he knew the journey would be dangerous, possibly deadly. Along for the ride with Vikander we have the amazing Walton Goggins as the main bad guy, and as mentioned earlier

> Dominic West as Lara's father, who mysteriously disapp-eared close 10 years to beforehand.

Over the years I have seen major Hollywood blockbuster movies that did not have the believability, and likeability that this

movie has, and that's down to Alicia Vikander's portrayal of Lara as she turns Lara Croft into a powerful woman, capable of taking down opponents with dexterity and speed-overcoming her smaller physical stature by being smarter and more clever than her opponents, and being deadly with a bow and arrow. As touched on earlier Vikander also manages to make the Lara Croft character very likeable, and memorable. She did this with her acting skills, not by just being a big-name Hollywood actress-like someone else tried to do before her. Welcome back Lara Croft, we want to see more of your adventures.
