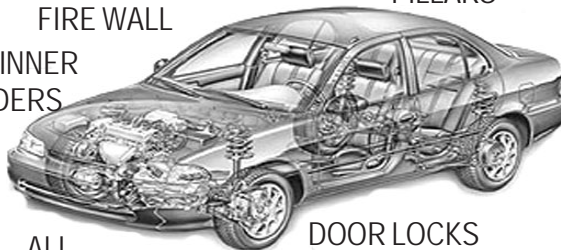

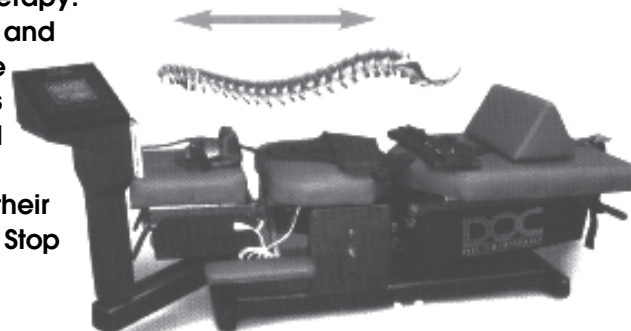

Sci-Fi - For as long as I can remember I have been a big fan of science fiction movies-or as some call it "Sci-Fi", or "SF". When it comes to literature though science fiction has been around longer than most people realize; in fact what is considered to be the first sci-fi story was written in the second century A.D., as Lucian's "A True Story" contained themes of travel to other worlds, alien life forms, galactic wars and artificial life forms. That is mind-boggling. The first science fiction movie

was "A Trip To The Moon" which was released in 1902, and 1927's "Metropolis" was the first sci fi feature length film. That is quite a history for sure.

So flash forward, or time travel per se to this week where I am going to look at 2 movies I watched; one excellent-one garbage.
