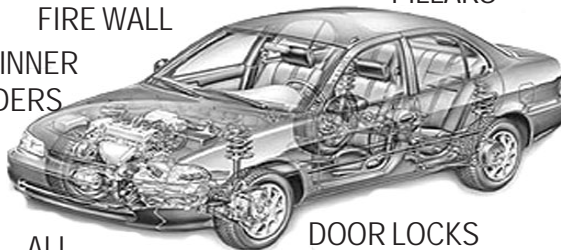

"A Quiet Place" - Like myself
 there are a lot of horror movie
 fans out there-but I am not so
 much a fan of the 'splatter/gore
 flicks' filled with mindless
 violence; for me the nasty action
 has to be part of the story-not
 the story in itself. I am more of a
 fan of 'gothic' style horror, and
 to that end I am
 always seeking
 horror films that
 stand out above
 the crowd for
 whatever
 reason, and I
 found a great
 one this week.
"A Quiet Place"
 is an amazing
 movie-but

Each evening the father lights
 a signal torch on top of a grain
 elevator to watch for, and
 confirm other torches-but over
 time the other torches are fewer
 and fewer, as humans fall prey
 to the beasts. Things heat up
 substantially as the mom goes
 into premature labour, and
 while making her way down to
 the soundproofed basement
 she walks on a huge nail in the
 stairs and drops a glass frame-
 the noise alerting the beasts
 that there's prey nearby. The
 tension
 amps up, as
 we watch and
 wonder how
 she can first
 deliver the
 baby silently-
 as well as
 cover the
 cries of a
 newborn.

some people might be put off
 by the fact that not a single word
 is uttered in the first 38 minutes.
 No, it is not a silent film-let me
 explain. The movie starts on
 "Day 89" of the year 2020, after
 some sort of invasion by
 creatures that look like a cross
 between a spider and a
 mummy; they are also blind but
 have super-sensitive hearing
 that can detect noises from
 miles away-and they kill and eat
 humans.

Actors John Krazinsli and Emily
 Blunt are the parents of 3
 children, but as the youngest
 one gets attacked and killed
 early on in the film we see what
 the dread and fear is all about,
 and it is terrifying. To compound
 matters their daughter is deaf,
 and the mom is pregnant.

The daughter's deafness
 becomes a central point in the
 film's plot as her dad tries in
 vain to scratch together a
 working hearing aid-mostly to
 no avail, until... sorry, no
 spoiler coming here, you'll have
 to watch the movie to see what
 happens. On that note, without
 giving away too much more the
 movie's ending is at first
 worrisome, then it takes a great
 twist and becomes a very
 satisfying one.

I have read that some critics
 called this movie a 'thinking
 man's horror film', and while
 that may sound a bit pretentious
 let's agree that the movie is very
 clever and doesn't resort to
 cheap shots to scare the viewer.
 It's actually one of the best, if
 not the best, horror flick I've
 seen so far this year. Enjoy!

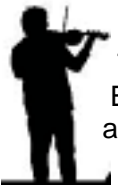
