





"Gotti" - The last few reviews I wrote were for sci-fi or horror movies, so it's a nice change of pace to take a look at a big box office biographical crime drama, starring John Travolta in a stellar portrayal of John Gotti-the boss of the Gambino crime family in New York city. At

his peak Gotti was one of the most powerful and dangerous men in the United States, and the Gambino family was the biggest crime syndicate in the country. Gotti was not shy of attention becoming known as the "Dapper Don" for



Being a biopic the film has to be as authentic as possible; it starts close to Gotti's end where John Gotti Junior is visiting his father in prison. The senior Gotti is dying of throat cancer and the son is there to explain why he is contemplating accepting a plea bargain for testimony about the crime syndicate in exchange for lesser time served in prison.

Gotti senior lived and died by the old mob code, and he was basically looked on as a local hero by the neighborhood, and only 'whacked' or hurt bad people. John Gotti wanted his son to live by that credo as well. For Gotti Jr. though it was more important to spend as little prison time away from his wife

and children as possible, and possibly redeem the Gotti name. John Gotti Jr. was indeed a "made man" and was in line to take over the family business-so he knew where 'the bodies were buried' as they say. He did end up serving a total of 9 years in prison-

being released in December of 2009. His father died in prison on June 10th, 2002.

Here's some interesting trivia about the movie: Pitbull was so amazed by a photograph of Travolta as Gotti that he asked if he could be included on the soundtrackand he was. Gotti family members were on-set during the production, and provided family videos for reference. Lindsay Lohan was supposed to be in the film but was too difficult to work with-so they canned her. I could spend the next hour writing about this movie, but mere words would not do it justice. The film is one of the best 'true life' productions I have seen in quite some time, a great look at the old days of the mafia. Watching this is an offer you can't refuse.

## BARTOWN FLASHBACK 1949

Arriving in North Sydney from Iona CB in 1949 my first memory of The Bar Town was a walk down its, Mainstreet .Starting at Jackson's Market,

I passed by St. Matthew Wesley United Church, Post Office, Cable Office, LA Steele Motors, Quality Store, Owl Drug Store, Paddy Keagan's Barber Shop, I glanced at Pilkintons, Chamber's, Tobacco Store. Balha's Confectionary Store, the Odeon Theatre, Lemoine's Grocery Store. Thompson Sutherland, 5 and 10, Fred Mac Leod and Son clothing store. Proceeding on, Whitman's clothing, Nelson Rice's Drug store. John Mac Donald's. 
