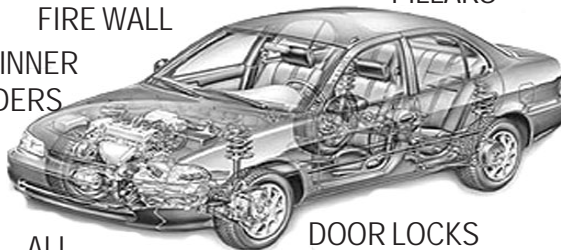

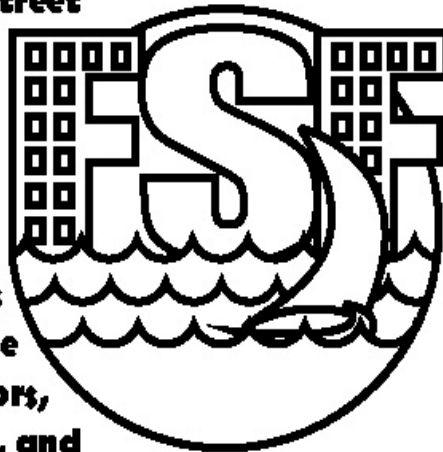

The Alarm – “Equals” - For this week I thought the time was right to return to notes about music-especially when I get the new release by the band The Alarm. I've written about The Alarm a few times over the years, and the 'Cole's Notes' are that the Alarm is an amazing alternative rock band from Wales; they formed way back in 1981 and were most popular in 1983, with songs like “68 Guns”, “The Stand” and “Strength”. Musically, The Alarm were very similar to early U2, appropriately so as U2 had the band open for them on North American tours.

The band has released 15 albums including this one-but it's been 8 years since their last album. Lead singer/band leader Mike Peters just had his second battle with cancer, and in 2015 his wife also had a cancer diagnosis. Both are in remission now-so things are looking better. Given all that, it comes as no surprise that this album is filled with emotion, optimism and bravery in the face of adversity. Things that The Alarm are well known for.

The album's first song is a big surprise; the band takes an almost dance music flair on “Two Rivers”, plus the song sounds so much like a U2

number. The Alarm are who they are as a musical entity and they always had that U2 sound, but it's not a copycat thing-they are contemporaries of Bono and the boys. The tracks “Beautiful”, “Peace Now” and “Transatlantic” come across like the musical children of U2 and Bruce Springsteen-they are all great songs. As for some of the other tracks, sonic ‘reminds me of’ moments show up on the Muse-heavy “Hell Fire” and “Coming Backwards” has a hint of The Cult to it. The oddly named “Thirteen Dead Reindeer” really carries a heavy Brit Pop tinge (think of the band Garbage) and is another great number, and the beautifully arranged “Cenotaph”

shines a light on just how good this band really is.

As mentioned earlier, the health scares sparked Mike and wife Jules to recently get over 170,000 people signed up to the International Bone Marrow Donor Registry through the work of their charity “Love Hope Strength”, and for Mike Peters recording this new album showed a steadfast dedication to the fans, and a refusal to be knocked down. Perhaps The Alarm put it best in the lyrics on the album's last song “Tomorrow”; “Stay true, stay strong, whatever you think you are today, you can be tomorrow”. This is a great album.
