



"The Purge" - I wrote years ago that this movie franchise was controversial and disturbing for a number of people. In 2013 "The Purge" was released to great fanfare, and abject horror. The concept of the movie? In order to cut down on crime and overcrowding the American government sanctioned a 12-hour period, once a year, where every crime is legal. No Police, no hospital services, no punishment. The end result was economic growth-and a society largely free of homeless, sick and unemployed people. It's the poor, the minorities and the defenseless that were being killed, which equaled lower welfare payments, hospital costs and crime rates. I found this movie bone-chilling, yet fascinating. The rich and the middle-class locked themselves up for the night and let the "99%-ers" rip each other to pieces. The movie made well over 150 million dollars, so obviously a lot of people watched it!

The next year "The Purge: Anarchy" was released, with some redemption in the fact that a group of freedom fighters (the founding fathers-who rule the government-called them terrorists) hacked into government media sources to denounce The Purge, and asked people not to take part in the violence and carnage. As the night fell, and the violence ramps up it was discovered that the founding fathers sent out mercenaries to jack up the killings as they wanted more poor folk dead. The movie ends as the sunrise shed a new light on the devastation-and the conspiracy by the rich.

The third release in the franchise, "The Purge-Election Year", had perfect timing with the real American election campaign. It's no longer a secret that the founding fathers are raking in billions by eliminating the poor, but senator Charlie Roan, a survivor of a family massacre that took place 18 years earlier during a purge, threatens their system. She wants to eliminate the purge and restore justice. equality and protection for all. The founding fathers decide to remove a law that prevents elected officials from being killed on purge night, hoping to gain points with the electorate. Their real aim is to kill the senator, keeping the status quo. Senator Roan wants nothing to do with violence, but unbeknownst to her a splinter group of supporters decide to assassinate the founding fathers on the purge night. So it's game-on for everyone. The movie has a surprise ending.

The newest release "The First Purge" comes full circle as a prequel to the first "Purge" movie, showing that what started off as a social science experiment in Staten Island was really a population control device. People would receive five thousand dollars if they stay in their homes during The Purge, and if they want to wear cameras to capture anything outside they will get more money. This film dovetails perfectly into the subsequent movies and is, like the other films, disturbing yet captivating. Enjoy!


