

MARWENCOL - Eight years ago I watched this documentary, and at the time it was probably the most unusual and captivating one I had ever seen. It chronicles the life of Mark Hogancamp, who was attacked in 2010 by 5 men outside a bar

in New York-they nearly beat him to death. Mark spent 9 days in a coma and another 40 days in the hospital. then was discharged because couldn't pay for the therapy. Mark had memories of his previous life

before the attack (a married navy man and an alcoholic) but found another life, and another world in the tiny town (literally) of Marwencol. Mark created the entire town in a one-sixth scale World War II Belgian town design-complete with inhabitants (think 12 inch G.I. Joe's and Jane's) and story lines for each figure.

A number of them look like his family and friends. For fans of military modelling and action figures (like myself) this film is a great treat to watch; the detail in everything is amazing. The documentary opens up with a photo collage of Mark's handiwork-and at first the majority of the shots look like living persons in outdoor

settings.

A visual testament to his attention to detail, even if it is obsessive. However, as the film progresses things get a bit darker, as Mark talks in-depth about the "inhabitants", their personal lives, and his own miniature-including it's violent torture by the SS, and his rescue by a number of 'resistance maidens'. This is where you can really see how the imaginary world of Marwencol

saved Mark's lifeeven if the whole notion flies in the face of conventionality, and to a certain degreesanity.

To show just how unique and captivating this documentary is, this Christmas actor Steve Carell

will star as Mark in the movie "Welcome to Marwen". With an all-star cast including Leslie Mann. Diane Kruger, Gwendoline Christie and Janelle Monae, to name a few. the tiny town will come alive on the big screen-bringing the world to Mark's Marwencol. Last week's column was about the movie "Elvira", and its behindthe-scenes documentary; before that I wrote about the making of movie "The Disaster Artist", and it's real inspirationthe film "The Room". In keeping with that theme-what is being released in December with Steve Carell, this is a great primer documentary-as the others were for their sister movies. Enjoy!
