WIN-WIN vs. WIN-LOSE: - PEACEFUL CONFLICT RESOLUTION ... is, to me, the aim of all good mediators.

Don't get me wrong: conflict is a healthy and important part of our everyday life. The word "conflict" seems to have such bad connotations, yet conflict resolution is around us all the time: the store clerk negotiating a week off work with his boss due to the sudden illness of his sister out west; the parent-teacher interview where the teacher needs to impress the farmer parents with their child's need for study time during harvest; the daughter negotiating with her mom for equal freedom with her brother with the car, business partners trying to fairly assign a variety of administrative versus operational business functions to make their business run more efficiently when one partner abhors the administrative portion of the business; the young couple wracked by sudden financial chaos in the midst of an unfortunate divorce.

Whether we are women or men, we cannot live without emotion: it is the lifeblood of motivation, the driving force behind our desire to achieve and treat others well, the very heart of our will to live from the moment of birth to our final days. And it can be emotion that so quickly gets us into trouble when we make an error in pivotal life- moments, when decisions are caught up in chaotic events, when we are devoid of helpful professionals who can help us wade through the mire of decisions that can follow through to good action.

So just who are these professionals and how can they help in these decisive times? For individual choices, we often go to a psychotherapist, a social worker, a life-choices professional, or a divorce coach, or even a friend who has some wisdom. For choices that involve others and commitment to decisive action, we can go to mediators where negotiations aim to produce a fair result for both or all parties.

Mediators can work with the persons involved alone, (say, in a, employee-employer problem) or if the parties have legal questions and problems (say in a partnership split, couple separation, or real estate or inheritance situation), they frequently work in tandem with or without legal advice being given to the parties along the way, or lawyers may accompany the parties to the mediation sessions if they wish. Communications are shared with the parties to define their own perspective on the issues needing resolution, and the common interests of the parties are more clearly defined. Sometimes even after 2-3 meetings one party will suddenly become clearly aware of which common interests are vital to the negotiations, and it is then that new and better solutions often come out of the woodwork!

So, what are the differences between legal negotiations and mediator negotiations? Frequently a good lawyer can ascribe fairness to decisions and choices, but too often a problem with the legal system is that it is often weighed down by a too -slow court/adversarial process, and by a win-lose perspective that often can harm relationships.

In mediation once common interests are defined, the parties (whether in open conflict or just trying to confidentially figure out how to address issues) are more aware of how their capacities can be more justly divided, appreciated and even shared or divided, new perspectives develop in the knowledge that instead of being silently in an emotional or legal war they can remain civil to each other or even restore their friendship, and with resolution remaining completely in their own hands, they move more quickly towards a more productive future.

Instead of their moving through months or years of confusion, interpersonal difficulty, or legal conflict, in mediation the parties are assisted to construct their own compromises that can be achieved fairly quickly, and they arrive at a resolution that ends the problem(s) for both much earlier, and at much less expense. 




