



The Wurzels - For this week I thought I'd get a bit stupid and silly (no comments please-LOL) and look way back at a band from Summerset County, England that's known to many, but usually for the wrong reasonand that reason can actually detract from their true talent as a great musical act, not just a novelty band. The Wurzels first saw their big

taste of fame with their 1976 hit "I Am A Cider Drinker"; people usually either love or hate this song, and some even put it in the same musical

To their credit, the band has released over 25 albums, with a few of them just all pop song covers, and a Christmas album.

So there you have itinternational hit makers from Southwest England, with music originally inspired by cider and taking the piss outta things. To sum up, "Ooh arrh, ooh arrh ay, Ooh arrh, ooh arrh ay...(Let cider be the spice o' loife! Arr!) Yes, I am also a cider drinker.

# TAX TIPS COLUMN

### Do you know you can deduct medical travel expenses?

Do you travel to Antigonish, or maybe Halifax for medical treatment? If you have to travel at least 80 kilometres (one way) from your home to obtain medical services, you may be able to claim accommodation, meal, and parking expenses in addition to your transportation expenses as medical expenses.

There are conditions to qualify for the claim of course, but they are simply that substantially equivalent medical services were not available near your home; you took a reasonably direct travelling route; and it is reasonable, under the circumstances, for you to have travelled to that place for those medical services.

Also if a medical practitioner certifies in writing that you were incapable of travelling alone to obtain medical services, you can also claim the transportation and travel expenses of an attendant who accompanied you.

For meal and vehicle expenses, you can choose to use the detailed method or the simplified method for calculating meal and vehicle expenses. If you use the detailed method, you have to keep all receipts and records for your 12-month period. The simplified method allows you to claim a flat rate of \$17/meal, to a maximum of \$51/day (sales tax included) per person, without receipts.

To use the simplified method to determine the amount you can claim for vehicle expenses, multiply the number of kilometres by the cents/km rate from the province or territory in which the travel begins. If your travel begins in Nova Scotia, the rate is 52.5 cents per kilometer.

You must keep receipts for all accommodation expenses and you must be able to show that the amount paid for accommodation is necessary because of the distance travelled and your medical condition. Claim the amount for accommodation as shown on your receipts and keep them in case the CRA asks to see them.
