



The Cranberries - "In The **End" -** To be honest this was an album that I wanted to hear so badly-yet didn't. Let me explain; in January of 2018 Dolores O'Riordan, the lead singer for The Cranberries, passed away at only 46 years of age. Looking back, since December of 1992 when the song "Dreams" came out Dolores, brothers Mike and Noel

Hogan and Fergal Lawler gave the world their Irish take on alternative rock music. "Dreams" was used for an Irish tourism campaign a number of years ago; that

ad campaign was what made me go "across the sea to Ireland" in the first place, so I always had a soft spot in my heart for Dolores's voice-and knowing that this is the band's last album is bittersweet. Noel Hogan stated: "the Cranberries was the four of us. We don't want to do this without Dolores. So we're going to leave it after this." Much of this album was recorded in 2017, but knowing that the band had the inner strength to return to the studio without Dolores to finish up is a comfort for the fans, and Noel also said, "Dolores was so energized by the prospect of making this record and to getting back out on the road to play the songs live." This

project had to be completed. but obviously Fittingly, unplanned, there is a sombre undercurrent that flows through most of the songs here, but the album kicks off with the rockier and aptly named "All Over Now", as that hauntingly beautiful voice flows from the speakers. "Wake Me Up When It's Over" has more of a down-tempo groove to it, that's even moreso with the song "Lost". Continuing on, when you hear "A Place I

> Know". "Catch Me If You Can" and T h e Pressure" vou feel that haunting atmosphere that The Cranberries were so successful at

conveying through their music, once again. There are two "Dreams"-like moments here on the tracks "Got It" and "Summer Song", which will both go down as some of the best numbers The Cranberries have ever done. When it was time to rock out and get heavier, the band kicked into "Crazy Heart"-this song is the epitome of a great alternative rock track. Again fittingly enough, the album ends with "In The End", and given the facts that Dolores O'Riordan is no longer with us, and that this is actually the end of The Cranberries, there couldn't be a better swan song. This album is indeed bittersweet-yet needs to be heard.

TAX TIPS COLUMN

NON-TAXABLE INCOME

Amounts which are not required to be included in income for tax purposes, so are not reported on a personal tax return, include:

- GST/HST credits
- Canada Child Benefit (CCB) payments and related provincial and territorial child benefits and credits
- disability insurance proceeds, depending on how the premiums were paid.
 - most gifts and inheritances
- lottery winnings, and raffle prizes, unless the circumstances deem that the proceeds are considered income from employment, business or property, or a prize for achievement. For instance, prizes from employer-promoted contests could be considered employment income. See Folio S3-F9-C1 below. The cost basis of property which has been won as a prize in connection with a lottery scheme is deemed by s. 52(4) of the Income Tax Act (ITA) to be the fair market value at the time it is won. This means that there is no capital gain if the prize is subsequently sold, unless it is sold for more than the amount deemed to be the cost basis. If a person decided to sell the right to the prize, (e.g., sell a winning \$1 million lottery ticket for \$900,000), s. 40(2)(f) of the ITA deems any gain or loss from this transaction to be nil.
- subject to certain exceptions (see Folio S3-F9-C1 below), an amount received as a windfall. Factors which indicate that an amount received is a windfall, which are based on The Queen v. Cranswick, [1982]CTC 69, 82 DTC 6073 (FCA):

the taxpayer had no enforceable claim to the payment,

- the taxpayer made no organized effort to receive the payment, the taxpayer neither sought after nor solicited the payment.

the taxpayer had no customary or specific expectation to receive the payment,
