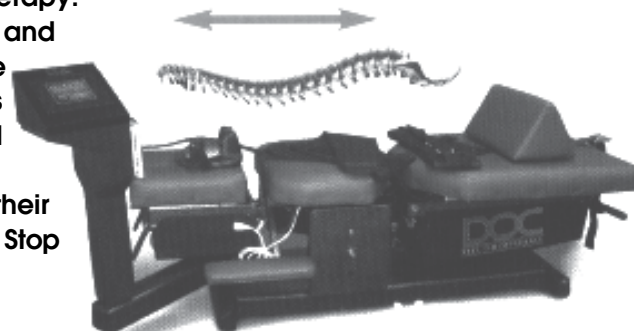

"Polaroid" Truth be told I wasn't planning on writing about this movie, and didn't really know anything about it until I saw the poster, and something about that caught my eye. By the way, just for fun I do intend on writing some puns here about cameras, and photography in general. Shall we see what develops? I did read some reviews for this movie (thankfully after the fact) that were not that positive; I don't know what those reviewers were expecting or what movie THEY watched. This film is pretty darn good, with a fairly original premise



in a world filled with unimaginative splatter flicks. As things come into focus here, you see where the originality comes into play. Without giving too much of the movie away, the storyline is all about a cursed Polaroid SX-70 camera that was used to take some very questionable pictures of....well...that's for you to find out by watching. A few online reviews were critical of the horror effects in the movie, but to me they were fairly original and fairly clever; the acting was good, sets and locations all added what they needed to to the story-without distracting from it (the way some bad CGI

effects can do) and the biggest surprise was in the last shot of the film....the Halifax bridge. The majority of the movie was filmed in Dartmouth, with the school scenes done at Prince Andrew High School. There aren't that many familiar names in this movie, with the exception of Mitch Pileggi (X-Files, SOA, NCIS) as the town sheriff, and Antigonish's own Shauna MacDonald (Trailer Park Boys). However, the lack of 'name' recognition doesn't mean a lot here; the actors are more than capable of carrying what I consider to be a good sleeper of a horror movie. Interestingly enough, this movie almost didn't get developed. The film was originally going to be released during the summer of 2017, but was pushed to December 1, 2017. Dimension Films then opted for a release date in time for Thanksgiving, debuting on November 22, 2017. Finally, three weeks before the release, Lantern Entertainment (previously known as The Weinstein Company) and Dimension Films put the movie on hold temporarily-due to the Harvey Weinstein scandal. All in all, it's better to watch a lower budget movie (it's not cheap looking though) with a good story than a mega-big bucks piece of doo-doo like "Hereditary" was. Enjoy!

TAX TIPS COLUMN

Parents, rejoice! The new 2018 federal budget amended the Employment Insurance (EI) parental sharing benefit, allowing parents to take up to five additional weeks of time off, starting in March 2019 after the birth or adoption of a child (a whole three months earlier than before). So, you can continue watching your toddler watch The Wiggles on repeat.

Here are a few things you'll want to take note of about the new benefit when it comes to qualifications:

- Parents with children born or placed for adoption on or after March 17, 2019 will be eligible.
- Parents including same-sex and adoptive parents are eligible for this credit only if both new parents share the time at home with the new baby – an effort to encourage families to share the responsibility of raising children, which is helping boost gender equality in the workplace.
- Parents selecting the standard duration of parental leave could receive up to 40 weeks of parental benefits (an increase from the current 35 weeks).

Parents selecting the extended duration of parental benefits could receive up to 69 weeks of parental benefits (an increase from the current 61 weeks). As well, the Working While on Claim rules now apply to sickness and maternity benefits. Grab your calculator, because this one requires some math to understand. While on maternity leave, some women choose to return to work early, before their EI benefits end. This is allowed and doable, but requires an adjustment in how much they receive in their benefits. A claimant receives 55% of their weekly salary as their EI benefit. When they return to work early, they must subtract 50 cents of each dollar they earn, and this amount will be subtracted from their overall EI benefit. (of purchase was previously 50%) – meaning the amount that can be claimed has tripled. Yes, this one totally deserves a fist-pump.
