

Take 2 with PAUL POWER

It's a pretty big deal anytime this dude releases a new album-with each one feeding anticipation and excitement. Is that warranted and earned with "Western Stars"? Let's say this right up front; "The Boss" had a definite grass roots/working class background-which plays well into the ethos that is Country

music. Bruce Springsteen's musical resume also covers the whole concept of storytelling, with words that reach people's heart and soul, for example the same dav released albums

"Human Touch" and "Lucky Town". With "Western Stars" Bruce strips back the layers of production, opting for a mix of acoustic guitar, piano and a bit of orchestration to present songs that seem to follow the theme of the open frontier, with its simplicity, and complexity as one digs deeper. The opening tracks, "Hitch Hikin" and "The Wayfarer" both play on the wandering theme-and the open road for new opportunities. The latter has a smooth cello intro that lifts the song up and carries it to a new place for the listener. As for some of the other tracks; "Tucson Train" is just beautiful, almost cinematic in its presentation, "Western Stars" is

pure old school Springsteen, even when dressed up as a Country song-which again proves how close "The Boss" has always been to this genre of music. "Sleepy Joe's Café" has an up-tempo groove that encourages toe-tapping and snapping. "Sundown" ebbs and flows like a river that's about to surge at any moment. This is a great song. To be honest though, the majority of the songs here are somewhat somber and

reflective.

big dreams and what was lostbut also what was gained. Closing off the album we have "Hello Sunshine"-a tune that has a 'Blues meets Country' vibe that is infectious, and "Moonlight Motel" seems like the end destination for the album's opening track, as the hitchhiking wayfarer makes it home to where he belongs, and where his journey ends. To close, Bruce Springsteen has crafted an absolutely beautiful album here, with rich, deep layers of colour and sonic landscapes that define both the beauty and desolation many face along their personal journey.
