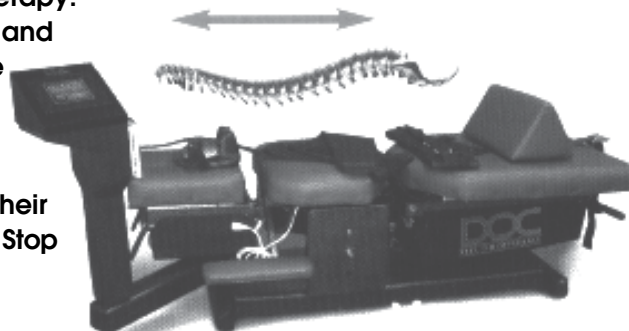

Take 2 with PAUL POWER

For this week's column I initially thought that I would need a bottle of wine and some crackers...expecting some real cheese. However this movie is not that bad. What first caught my attention about "Iron Sky: The Coming Race" was the promise of dinosaurs living in a hollow middle Earth, Nazi's on the moon-and Canada's own Tom Greene. What's not to like, right? As an old-school Sci-Fi fan I like it when movies don't depend solely on CGI effects, but when they are used the effects look fresh and original. In this tale the costumes, weapons and ships fit the look of a worn out and decimated



planet. Heck, one spaceship is basically an army tank with rockets on it! I must backtrack a bit; in a nutshell this movie is the sequel to 2012's "Iron Sky", in which an American mission lands on the moon. The astronauts encounter the descendants of Nazi's who fled Earth for the moon in 1945 after being defeated. One of the Nazi scientists uses the astronaut's smartphone for it's computing power to complete their spaceship-which they then use to return to Earth in 2018 with the goal of conquering it. Soon after arriving they plan global
