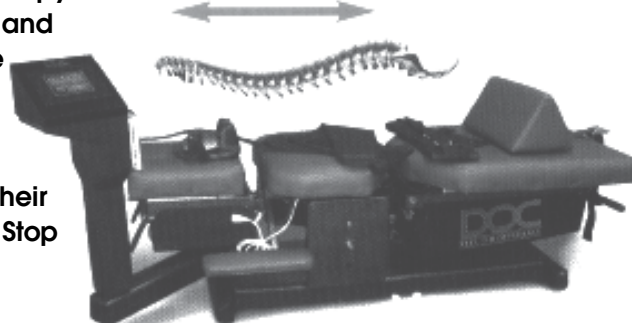

New Year's Day Story

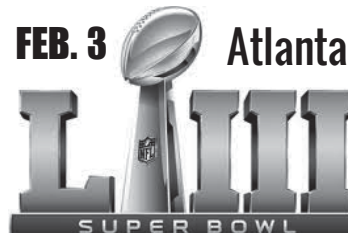
A married couple had been out shopping for most of the day. Suddenly the wife realised that her husband had "disappeared".

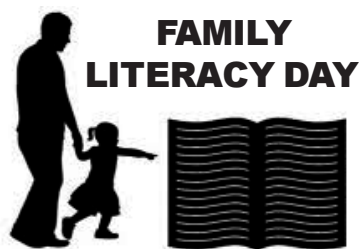

Captain & Tennille - To be honest I actually had another column finished for this week, but when I heard about Daryl Dragon passing on January 2nd. I thought it was more fitting to write this one instead. Daryl ("Captain") was better known as half of the duo Captain & Tennille. They were a husband and wife team that first came to musical prominence in 1975 with their cover of Neil Sedaka's "Love Will Keep Us Together", scoring a number 1 hit with the song. By the way- Tennille is Tony Tennille, and she is often referred to as the Beach Boys only "Beach Girl" because she toured with the boys for about a year, playing keyboards.



From 1975 onward for approximately 5 years Captain & Tennille racked up a series of hit songs; "Muskrat Love", "Shop Around", "Do That To Me One More Time" and "The Way I Want To Touch You" to name a few. The duo were so popular that they were given their own very successful weekly television show in 1976-but within a year they wanted to concentrate more on music and touring, and left the small screen. Although Captain & Tennille saw their popularity on the charts wain after 1980, in the years leading up to that Toni Tennille was a sought-after session musician; she did back up vocals for Elton John's "Don't Let The Sun Go

Down On Me" and Pink Floyd's "The Wall" album. When C&T released their "Ultimate Collection Greatest Hits" package a number of years ago Toni mentioned the following funny anecdote; "I went to see the Pink Floyd concert at the Sports Arena in Los Angeles. There was a 15-year-old boy sitting in front of me who recognized me. He turned around and snottily said, 'What are YOU doing here?'"

So I told him I sang on the album. He ran off to find a friend who had brought the LP to the show, and looked at the back to see if my name was really on there. A few minutes later, he came back and apologetically said, 'Can I have y o u r

autograph?'" Throughout the 1980's and the 1990's the duo toured and performed quite often-but Toni soon moved towards a solo career, releasing a number of albums.

Their last release as a duo was a Christmas album in 2007. Toni Tennille filed for a divorce from Daryl Dragon almost 5 years ago, and released her memoir in 2016, painting a less than perfect picture of their marriage. However, that doesn't diminish the duo's lasting impact on the music scene in the 1970's, giving us songs that defined the sound of the 70's. Daryl Dragon died on January 2, 2019, from kidney failure. He was 76.

Dogs, in 1957, were free to roam at will and it was like a wish come true to have two "reindeer" suddenly appear.

Two German shepherd dogs began chasing the "reindeer" as if they were the Hounds of the Baskerville and the two deer were muttering Gaelic curses and trying to kick the dogs off. The kids, who were supposed to have an unforgettable memory, were treated to snarling dogs, kicking reindeer and one neighbour who actually thought two deer were out in the yard and went for his hunting rifle.

The lights went on all over the neighbourhood, the two reindeer finally made it to safety by locking themselves in Lloyd Piercey's barn. The dogs were in rare form snarling and barking and when the police arrived, they had to be physically restrained.

The police ordered the two "reindeer" to surrender and finally were allowed to go when the whole story was revealed and it was determined that nobody was trying to steal anything. We finally went to bed after being convinced by our mother that Santa's reindeer were okay and they would be ready to fly tonight to bring our presents.
