





As if that wasn't enough, Depp shines even brighter on the ex-New York Dolls Johnny Thunder's song "You Can't Put Your Arms Around A Memory". It's not all

Depp, all the time, here though-Alice Cooper's voice actually opens the album with the sleazy rock track "I Want My Now". My favourite song on the whole album is definitely "Who's Laughing Now", as The Coop takes a swipe at society's elites who fall from grace. It's great to hear that even at the age of 71 Alice Cooper still has that

evil, impish streak that made him so famous since 1971. Depp's back-up vocals are great on this track as well. Admittedly a number of the songs here do sound as if they were lifted from an Alice Cooper album; "Mr. Spider", "New Threat" and "The Boogieman Surprise" all have that politically-charged, ironic and sarcastic Cooper bite to themwhich is a good thing. The album ends with a spokenword piece, as the main three Vampires wax apocalyptic about trials, tribulations and the journeys through a hard life. The Hollywood Vampires have risen from the dead once again to feast on our.....ears. Enjoy!
