



Take 2 with PAUL POWER

Without realizing it last week I missed the date marking the 20th anniversary release of one of the most groundbreaking and influential horror movies of all time-"The Blair Witch Project", so here's my catch-up column. Even though this film was preceded by "Cannibal Holocaust" as the first "found footage film", "Blair Witch" popularized the genreand set an astounding

precedent by costing \$60,000 to make-and making over 250 million dollars in profit. For those who didn't see this movie the story line details the misadventures of three film students doing research on the local legend of the Blair Witch, in Burkittsville,

Maryland. They hike into the forest, camp there-and Their film disappear. equipment is recovered, and the footage shows what happened to the trio. I worked in television production for almost 30 years and I know that 'faking-or creating' found footage is a hard game to play convincingly; "The Blair Witch Project" mastered that feat, right down to condensation building up on the camera lens, frantic movements, running through deep woods, and genuine looking panic and fatigue as the actors were made to cover long distances each day, actually getting lost at times, the crew harassing them each night and limiting food. Clues were also given out sporadically as to the next filming locations. Another brilliant thing about this movie was the ad campaign; before its premiere at the 1999 Sundance Film Festival posters of the actors were circulated stating that the actors were missing, or dead. When the film was picked up by a major entertainment label they did the same thing, as well as producing television commercials that presented the film as a real event, a documentary. There was also a fake documentary produced by the directors Daniel Myrick

> and Eduardo Sanchez for the SciFi Channel "The called Curse of the Blair Witch"; it was released prior to the actual film's release. All this conspired to make audiences believe that they were watching true events, which some still do. To

this day some people hate found footage films, some also find that viewing them gives them motion sickness, but some people really like them (I do when they're done well, like this movie, "Cloverfield") and I remember that when I saw this movie in the theatre many in the audience, like myself, just sat there wondering what it was that we had just viewed, as the ending was jarring, and creepy as old Hell. There were actually 4 different endings filmed, but in advanced testing with audiences they mostly preferred the original-and somewhat open ended close. So Happy Birthday to "The Blair Witch".
