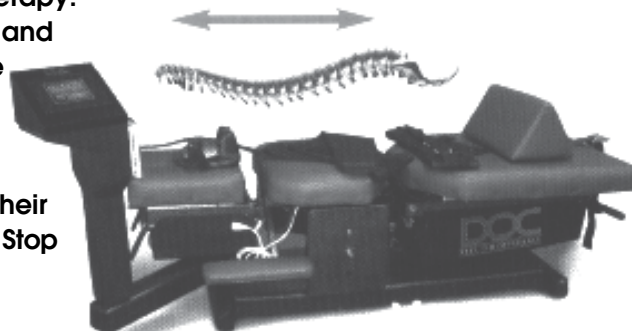

No, this "Fisherman's Friends" is actually a film based on the true story of the singing Fishermen from the small Atlantic coast village of Port Isaac in Cornwall, England-and it is a treat to watch. It's easy for us East-Coasters to relate to this movie, as the men sing sea shanty songs, some of which

go back hundreds of years. As the story goes, some London music label big-wigs are on a stag weekend to

the little village and happen to catch a performance by the Fishermen. The boss challenges one of his underlings to sign the Fishermen up to the label (all the while not telling the hapless employee that the whole thing is a lark). The Fishermen are no fools though, being very skeptical of the offer, but the record label exec eventually wins them over. Over the course of the movie that exec learns valuable life lessons, and falls in love with a village girl. The scenery alone in this movie makes it worth watching-especially for us Bluenosers, and the fact that it's based on a truly great story, all drag the

viewer onboard for the journey. The film has a great line-up of actors: Daniel Mays, James Purefoy (the most recognizable actor), Tuppence Middleton, David Hayman, Noel Clarke, Dave Johns, Maggie Steed, Sam Swainsbury and Christian Bassington all brilliantly present characters that are so homelike, and familiar. The movie ends with a photo montage of, and music by the real Fisherman's Friends-and also mentions the fact that the album the men released in 2010 reached Gold status, and was in the Top 10 album chart in the United Kingdom. The end credits also pay respects to the tour manager Paul McMullen and singer Trevor Gillis, both of whom died when there was an accident with a steel door that fell on them at the venue before a concert. This is a great movie.
