Take 2 with PAUL POWER

Well, here we are again; Willie Nelson recently released this album, "Ride Me Back Home", which makes it album number 6 in the last 3 years from him (number 69 of his recording career). That is definitely a prolific output for any musician, especially for one

that's 86 years old.
I recently read a
Rolling Stone
magazine article
about Willie, which
was not so much
about his music-it
was about his
claim that
cannabis saved
his life, and he's

been smoking pot since the 1960's. Willie is also a staunch supporter and campaigner for legalized marijuana, and has business ventures involving cannabis-all putting him right up there with Snoop Dogg, but we all know that Willie is way cooler. So with this being Willie Nelson's 69th album you have to wonder where he finds enough new material to keep chugging along. In this case its actually a mix of new material and cover songs. The album starts off with it's title track, an ode to old horses who worked all their lives-with the chorus of "Now they don't need you, there's no one to feed you, there's fences where you used to roam, I wish I could gather up all of your brothers and you would just ride me back home." The song is very much an 'old school' Willie Nelson song, and Willie actually has over 60 rescue horses on his property, so it's a subject that's near and dear to his heart. As mentioned, there are a number of cover songs on the album; Billy Joel's "Just The Way You Are" gets a much-to-the-original treatment here, as does Mac Davis's hit song "It's Hard To Be Humble". There seems to be a sense of mortality in a lot of the songs here-sonic nods to leaving this

mortal coil; "One More Song To Write" is a joyous ode to all the things that still need to be done, and "Maybe I Should Have Been Listening" is a regretful admission of what should have been-

but "Come On Time" is a bopping, honky-tonk influenced challenge to the emptying hourglass, all the while knowing that time is something you can't actually kill. Willie Nelson is at his best on the Skip Denenberg/ Dan "Bee" Spears song "Nobody's Listening", with the lyrics "in these days of change and mass communication, seems like no one's plugged into the sounds desperation...and the singer sings his song, and he tries to impart all the troubles going on weighing heavy on his heart, what good is a song that he has to sing when nobody's listening, but I know why he has to try to sing, cause he believes that somebody's listening." Here's to hoping that Willie has many more great songs like these to sing.
