





The best parts in the whole film are the droll, deadpan lines Adam Driver's character delivers, and the recurring song "The Dead Don't Die" by Sturgill

> Simpson (who actually has a cameo in the movie as a guitar dragging zombie) that most of the characters love. but Bill Murray's hates it. I don't want to say this film is terrible-it's far from it, but writer/director Jim Jarmusch is known for quirky, underground films that are 'left of mainstream'. In this case, he made a

movie that's indeed quirky as hell-with a few good parts, but it also doesn't hold a candle in comparison to the movie "Zombieland", with a similar premise and a ton of star power actors as well. So there you have it-a slightly cautionary tale of a zombie apocalypse, and one of how not to waste a few hours.
