





"Bad, Worse and Terrible"

I have written here before that I am a fan of horror movies-but only ones that are not an insult to the viewer's intelligence, with gratuitous violence and gore trying to cover up for a lack of vision, and plot. So this week I am offering a warning about 3 movies; first the BAD-"HellFest" (which is also the name of a European heavy metal festival) tells a tale that is so predictable; a bunch of teenagers go to the scariest horror-themed amusement park they can find for spooky fun. The acting is not that bad, but the serial killer who slavs with impunity (remember-it's a horror park so he blends in with the crew) follows victims, and whistles the nursery rhyme song "Ring around the Rosie". Why? At the end of all the killing he goes home and greets his young daughter with the same tune-yes, I spoiled the ending-but this movie deserved that. The WORSE is "Mandy"-a movie that is so whacked out the producer. director and crew must have been on acid or mushrooms during the making of it. The only small plus here is Nicholas Cage's 'over-the-top' psychotically-charged performance as a revenge seeking maniac who hacks,

chops and slashes his way through the cult that killed his girlfriend. Actor Linus Roche (King Ecbert of "Vikings") plays the creepy, sleazy cult leader: Linus is better than this, but maybe paycheque was something he couldn't refuse. Now, the TERRIBLE; "Tales of Poe". Directors Bart Mastronardi & Alan Rowe Kelly should have called their "Tales of Poe" movie "Tales of Poo", because this movie is crap. It's a trilogy of stories based on the writings of Edgar Allan Poe.

The directors seem to think that unnecessary, incessant and annoying screaming and contorted scowls on the actors faces can make up for schlock-it doesn't. This movie has some of the worst acting I have ever seen. It makes Tonny Wiseau's acting skills look like Sir Lawrence Olivier.

TAX TIPS COLUMN

When should you expect your tax slips?

T4(Employment):-Employers are required to distribute T4s by February 28th, 2019.

T4A(Wage loss replacement benefits, scholarships and pensions): These income slips are required to be distributed by February 28th, 2019. T4E(Employment Insurance Benefits): - Through My Service Canada Account, you can view and print your T4E as early as February 4th.

All Service Canada slips for taxation year 2018 will be issued by mail between January 30th and February 28th, 2019.

T4(P)/T4(OAS)(CPP Benefits):-Through My Service Canada Account, you can view and print your T4(P) & T4(OAS) as early as February 4th.

All Service Canada slips for taxation year 2018 will be issued by mail between January 30th and February 28th, 2019.

T3/T5013(Investment Income): These two slips are not required to be mailed out until March 31st. 2019.

T5(Investment Income): - Investment income slips are required to be distributed by February 28th. 2019.

T5007(Social Assistance and WCB Benefits):- These income slips are required to be distributed by February 28th, 2019.

T2202A(Tuition and Education):-Through your school's web portal, you may view and print your slip as early as February 4th, and they are required to be available by February 28th, 2019 at the latest.

RRSP:-There is no specific deadline by which financial institutions must issue RRSP receipts. However, most of them recognize that you want them as soon as possible and try to comply. Remember that contributions you make in the first 60 days of 2019 must be recorded on the 2018 tax return. so if you decide not to wait you will need to file an adjustment later. Before you file, check your online banking site for download options.

MOST IMPORTANTLY, the Canada Revenue Agency has now closed the EFILE system for annual maintenance, and therefore no tax return in Canada can be Efiled until it reopens on February 18th. 2019. So there's no rush yet. take some time and be sure you have all of your slips before you file.
