But things were about to change. Calvin Boutilier had a sling shot with him and to spice things up a little, he decided to take a shot at the horse. He let fly with a small pellet and it hit the horse clear on the rump The horse reared up and began to trot. The girls screamed and the boys held on for dear life. The driver did his level best to control the runaway horse.

Just as things were getting under control, the sleigh runners slipped off the path and the sleigh tipped on its side. Hay bales, girls, blankets and 1 startled teacher all went flopping to one side. Fortunately there were no injuries but everybody was shook up. The driver was able to get the horses back on the path and we continued back to the starting point at the normal pace.

The driver apologized for the horses and wondered aloud why they reared as they did. Nobody said anything but all the boys looked at Calvin. We went back to school on Monday and the story spread but of course it was enhanced by the boys to a life and death struggle for survival. But each year when our family goes for its annual sleigh ride, I keep a close watch on all the boys aboard the sleigh, looking for any telltale signs of mischief. It doesn't hurt to be careful.

Take 2 with PAUL POWER

For this week's review I've chosen to write about one of the most controversial documentaries I have ever seen; "Hail Satan?". The gist of the documentary is how The Satanic Temple "TST" (formed in 2013 by Lucien Greaves Malcolm Jarrvinterestingly enough based in

Salem Massachusetts) used the state of Arkansas's own laws on the separation of church and state against it to promote the erecting of TST's Baphomet (the satanic goat purportedly

worshiped by the Knights' Templar-and TST) statue right alongside the existing monument of The Ten Commandments. According to their press releases The Satanic Temple uses Satanic imagery to promote equality, social justice, and ultimately, again, the separation of church and state. Their stated mission is "to encourage benevolence and empathy among all people". There's a great sequence in the doc detailing the Satanic Panic from the 1970's to the 1990'stouching on everything from Oprah, to heavy metal music, to Dungeons and Dragons and davcare centre satanic

abuses-all lies. The Satanic Temple uses satire, theatrical ploys, humor and direct legal action in their public campaigns to "generate attention and prompt people to reevaluate fears and perceptions", and to "highlight religious hypocrisy and encroachment on religious freedom". All of this plays out in living colour in this documentary as The Satanic Temple shines a light on how Christian values are creeping back into American society's

> political system on every level. Ironically, the whole idea of erecting Ten Commandments statues around the U.S. started in 1956. as a movie tie-in for Charlton Heston's "The Commandments". For the most part the

> independent

filmmaker Penny Lane chose eloquent and intelligent people from TST for the on-camera interviews, which quickly gets juxtaposed with the fervent, eternal damnation venting of the born-again Christians in the film. As the documentary plays out TST takes the step of banning a member when she endorses violence and overt illegal actions-things that TST stands against. Interestingly enough, when Penny Lane finished making this documentary she became a member of TST. Again, this documentary is controversial, and to some it's thought-provoking, to others pure evil. Which one is it? That is up to you.
