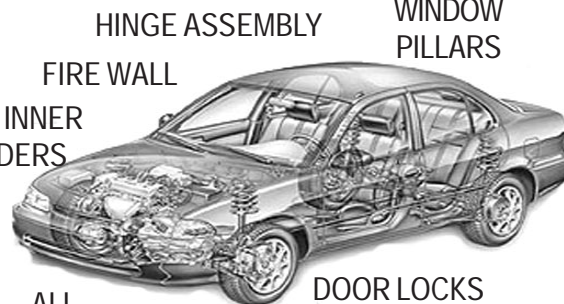

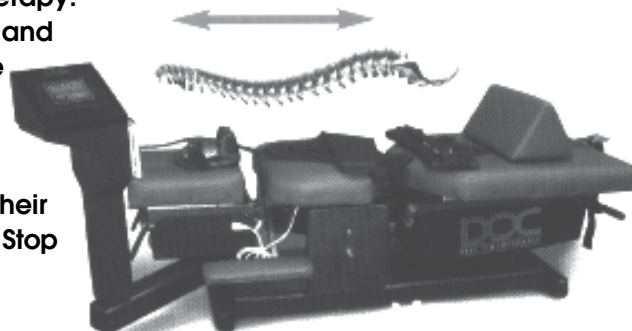

ON DASHER! ON DANCER!

Ideas often come at the oddest moments in one's life. They spring to life and, if they appeal to the inner child in most of us, they are acted upon without much forethought. I want to share with you one such idea that occurred at Christmas, 1957.

Kids always like to see reindeer in a parade or hear stories of Rudolph and all of Santa's other faithful companions. Fathers are always soft touches when it comes to Christmas and their children. They want the best for them.

We were no different from most families in Cape Breton. Our dad worked at the Sydney Steel Plant and we all loved Christmas and all the magic of the whole season. My father loved to hunt and fish as well. One Winter, just before Christmas, my father and his buddy Lauchie MacGuigan had bagged two very nice bucks in Margaree.

Over beers one Saturday night while watching the hockey game, they came up with the idea that they would use the two deer hides and the heads and dress up as reindeer and have the kids look out the window and see the deer. Lauchie even had hooked up a battery operated red light and placed it on one deer's head to make it look like Rudolph.

So far, this seems like a wonderful idea for the children at Christmas. It would be the highlight of the year for their kids to actually see a real deer out in the yard. They would stay far enough away from the house so as to appear as real deer.

Well, I for one, can assure you that we never forgot this very special Christmas. On Christmas Eve, it was pre-arranged to have Mother tell us the story of Santa's reindeer and then to suddenly look out the window and see the dream come alive. Well, that was the plan, and admittedly, it was a very nice gesture on the dad's behalf.

However, to quote a phrase, the devil's in the details. The two "reindeer" donned the hides and heads and sneaked into the back yard at the pre-arranged time. However, they neglected to tell the neighbours of their plan and also did not factor the dogs into the plan. Dogs, in 1957, were free to roam at will and it was like a wish come true to have two "reindeer" suddenly appear.

The two German shepherds began chasing the "reindeer" as if they were the Hounds of the Baskerville and the two deer were muttering Gaelic curses and trying to kick the dogs off. The kids, who were supposed to have an unforgettable memory, were treated to snarling dogs, kicking reindeer and one neighbour who actually thought two deer were out in the yard and went for his hunting rifle.

The lights went on all over the neighbourhood, the two reindeer finally made it to safety by locking themselves in Lloyd Piercy's barn. The dogs were in rare form snarling and barking and when the police arrived, they had to be physically restrained.

The police ordered the two "reindeer" to surrender and finally were allowed to go when the whole story was revealed and it was determined that nobody was trying to steal anything. We finally went to bed after being convinced by our mother that Santa's reindeer were okay and they would be ready to fly tonight to bring our presents.

Oh yes, it was a memorable night. On Dasher, On Dancer, On Prancer and Vixen

mockumentary comedy series called "The Office", created by - and featuring Ricky Gervais. 2 years later

the series got an American treatment from Steve Carrell - and the rest is TV history. Since that time I have tried to watch every production involving Ricky Gervais, and they have all been brilliant; "Derek" and "Extras" were wonderful, but it's been his darker comedies that shine the brightest, with "Afterlife" (about a man whose life is turned upside down when his wife dies) and this show "Life's Too Short" being 2 of his best. Basically this show follows actor Warwick Davies around (again a

mockumentary) as he plays a fictionalized version of himself who is basically, well, a dick. He runs a talent agency for "Dwarves" (his words) but steals all the good roles for himself, all the while trying to milk everything he can from his past roles in "Star Wars", "Willow", "Leprechaun" and "Harry Potter" to name just a few from his resume. Warwick is amazing at playing a totally self-centered, self-absorbed actor who tries to ingratiate himself into the friendship circles of actors like Johnny Depp, Right Said Fred, Liam Neeson, Ricky Gervais, Stephen Merchant (who plays

a friend of Warwick's - along with Ricky Gervais), Sting (remember, he does act) and Steve Carrell.



Every episode covers a train wreck of disasters that Davis gets caught up in - usually all of his own making - plus he's somewhat racist against "little people" (his words again). Overall, you can't help but like Warwick Davis though in this series - he's still charming, and has a big heart - but sometimes gets lost in his crazed desire to get back into the showbiz limelight. By the way, there's only 10 shows in the series so it's a small viewing commitment for a big entertainment return. Enjoy!
