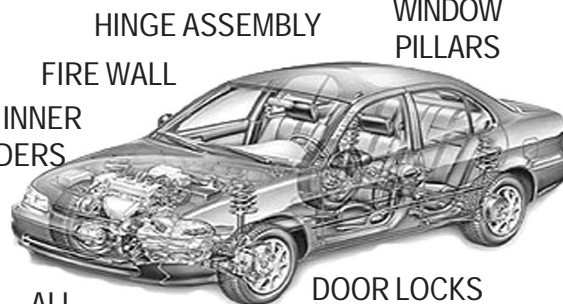

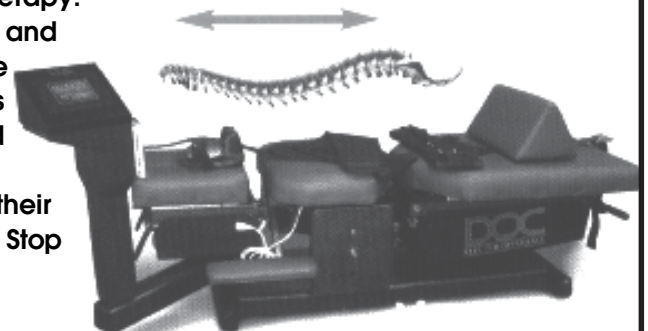

## A PARTRIDGE IN A PEAR TREE

We have all heard the Christmas Song "A Partridge In A Pear Tree" and this is a heart warming story of a hopeless romantic who tried to recreate the song in present form for his fiancé for their first Christmas.

By dinnertime we were getting a little bored but we stayed with it. At four o'clock without any sign of the partridge, we decided we would alter the plan and set off to capture a pigeon.

This was our second choice by we figured "what the heck, a bird is a bird" and besides it wasn't our girl friend we were getting the bird for anyway. We arrived back at the apartment and Dan had all the presents set. We suggested that he tie the "partridge" on the top of the tree with a small piece of transparent fishing line so he would stay in place.

I have to admit the tree was looking pretty good and he invited all our family and his girlfriend's family over for the presentation. Well, the tree was a huge success and Dan's fiancé, Barb, was happy beyond belief. Yes, everything was fine until someone decided to take a picture.

The "partridge" had been sitting quietly perched on the top of the tree. When the first camera flash went off, the pigeon flapped its wings in a frenzy and the girls started to scream. The tree was rocking and the bird finally snapped the fishing line and was free. It flew around inside the house and was banging the walls and knocking pictures and lamps over until finally we opened the door and he escaped into the frosty night.

Chaos reigned inside. Barb was crying, Dan was just stunned, her father was surveying the damage and I was outside rolling on the lawn in hysterical laughter. So, that's the reason I never try to get too romantic because I saw the results first hand. .... and a partridge in a pear tree.

Since this is my first column for December I wanted to set the theme for the month by writing some festive musings. 55 years ago "Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer" was released. This animated Christmas classic was produced in 1964 by the American production company Rankin/Bass, who were masters at spectacular stop-motion animation specials (their method

became known as "Animagic"). "Rudolph" featured the voice of Burl Ives as "Sam the Snowman" who told the story of how that timid little reindeer went 'down in history' by saving Christmas for all the little boys and girls around the world. Interestingly enough, Rudolph was actually voiced by the late Canadian voice actress Billie Mae Richards, who was the voice of Tenderheart Bear of "The Care Bears", and appeared in the original "Spiderman" TV series, the Canadian TV series "My Secret Identity", "War of the Worlds" and "Maniac Mansion", to name just a few.

"Rudolph" was all created by hand, with three-dimensional miniature sets, props and characters-all painstakingly moved a fraction of an inch by a fraction of an inch to create

something that was a technical innovation. The fact that the show has stood the test of time speaks volumes about its innocence, magic and charm. Who can ever forget seeing that lovable little reindeer, the comically terrifying Abominable Snow Monster of the North (a.k.a. The Bumble), Yukon Cornelius the prospector, the Island of Misfit Toys with Dolly the Ragdoll, the boy Hermy and the girl Clarice-and of course Mrs. Claus. For 20 plus years Rankin/Bass Productions made a huge number of animated projects, and other



stop-motion holiday specials such as "Rudolph's Shiny New Year", "Rudolph and Frosty's Christmas in July", "The Little Drummer Boy", "Frosty the Snowman" and "The Easter Bunny is Coming

to Town" to name just a few. Their last stop-motion production was "The Life and Adventures of Santa Claus" in 1985; unfortunately the company shut down in 1987. You will find Rudolph's wonderful tale on lots of screens as you read this, and the regional library has a complete DVD collection of Rankin Bass productions for loan. "Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer" is without a doubt one of the greatest Christmas programs for kids of all ages-right up there with "It's a Charlie Brown Christmas" (1965). For next week we have some spooky yuletide fun.
