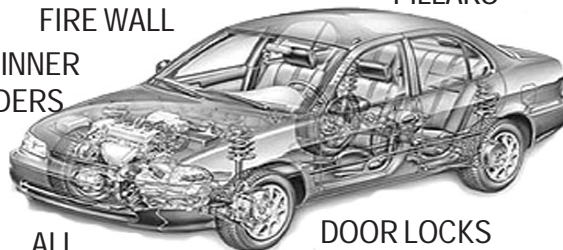

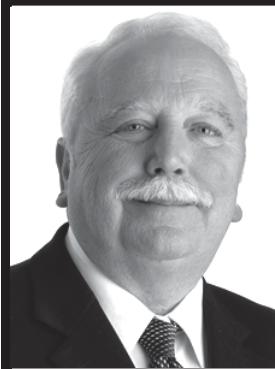

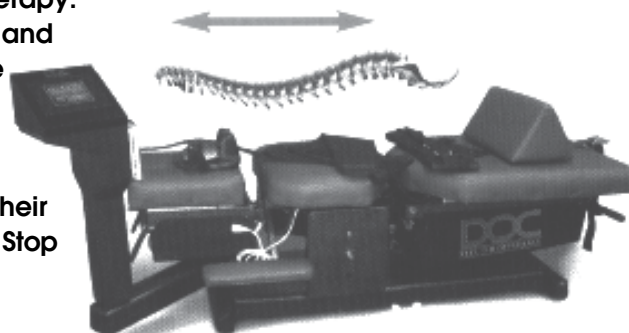

Season's Greetings, and welcome to my Christmas Eve column. Last week I wrote about the evil Christmas beast known as Krampus; this week I thought it would be more fitting to usher in tomorrow properly with a family-oriented yuletide film—one that you've no doubt seen numerous times already, but it's worth another look. Thirty-six years ago we all heard that now famous line "you'll shoot your eye out!" (which Ralphie almost did) as the movie's main character Ralphie Parker in "A Christmas Story" saw his dreams of getting a Red Rider BB gun crushed over and over. Ah yes, who could also ever forget that sexy leg lamp (it was Italian "fragile") or Ralphie's pink bunny suit, or the father's non-swearing swearing in his battles with the almost demonic furnace, a tongue stuck to a frozen flagpole or the ginger bully Scut Farkas. The movie was based on the novel "In God We Trust, All Others Pay Cash" by Jean Shepherd—and the main irony of "A Christmas Story" was that the movie was somewhat overlooked by a lot of critics when it was first released in 1983 (what do they know—right?) although Roger Ebert said the



movie had the best 'visit to Santa' scene he'd ever watched. Time changes all, and due to the increased popularity of this film in 1997 Turner Network Television (TNT) began a 24-hour marathon called "24 Hours of A Christmas Story," with the film being shown 12 times in a row beginning at 7p.m. on Christmas Eve, and ending on Christmas Day. The film was released on November 18, 1983 and earned two

Canadian Genie Awards in 1984 (parts of the movie were filmed in Canada) and in 2012 it was selected for preservation in the National Film Registry by the U.S. Library of Congress for being "historically, culturally or aesthetically

significant". The film was also voted the number one Christmas movie of all time in 2007 by AOL. How's that for a legacy, as well as the abundance of popular movie-related decorations and props available over the years for it's legions of fans. Heck, you can even buy your very own Italian "frageelee" leg lamp! It's living proof that this movie is 'must watch' viewing for over the holiday season. BTW—make sure you're on the Nice list because you know who's dropping by tonight. Ho Ho Ho, and Merry Christmas to all! See you all next year!
