





The Story of Anvil" DVD It's not often that I get to write a review for a music documentary about a legendary Heavy Metal band that's going to perform in Sydney Mines (April 30 and May

THE STORY OF ANVIL

On first view it would be easy for one to think that they stumbled onto a satire, Ala "Spinal Tap", a comedy of errors. Plus, the coincidence that the director of "This is Spinal Tap" was Rob Reiner ("All in the Family" fame) and the

drummer for Anvil is Robb Reiner. That's where the similarities end though-this DVD is not a comedic farce: it's real-sometimes too real, and the life and times of Anvil are laid bare for all to see. They are indeed tragic and unjust-but at the same time inspiring. In the early 1980's Anvil shared the stage with the likes of Bon Jovi and Whitesnake, and influenced bands such as Slaver, Anthrax and Metallica: Lars Ulrich even shows up here to tell us just how inspiring and influential Anvil were to Metal bands who went on to greater success and fame. So what happened to Anvil? Why was fortune and fame so elusive? This feature presents a bunch of normal guys who live and

breathe rock and roll and did everything they could to succeed-and it's as if the cosmos conspired against Anvil time after time after time. As the story progresses the band gets a new manager who defines the word "inept"; the band getting lost on the way to a gig, or playing before 174 people in a 10,000 capacity venue, and on and on the bad luck continued.

1) but here it is: "The Story of Anvil". "The GREATEST MOVIE EVER MADE ABOUT BOCK AND ROLL." (The heart and soul of the band is definitely Steve "Lips"Kudlow; even after decades of disappointment and heartache-and doing iobs such as deliveries for a catering company (which he never complained about in this doc) Lips is still searching for that "big

break". It's as if he's Don Quixote-and the windmills are fame and fortune. However, after this doc was released it did so much for the band; they played several festivals, including the Download Festival-headlining the Tuborg stage. As well as opening for AC/DC and Saxonand sharing the stage with Scott Ian of Anthrax, Also, albums were re-released, a book was written about the band and they were in the movie "The Green Hornet"-and last year Anvil released their seventh album. Blacksmiths forge metal on an anvil, which means that the anvil is stronger than the metal: Anvil are indeed stronger than metal because they ARE Heavy Metal, and this rockumentary is forged in that same fire.

DIABETIC? TRACK YOUR TIME - If you're diabetic, keep a record of how much time you spend on life-sustaining therapy. Since May 2017, the CRA denied disability claims for Type 1 diabetes, because they didn't think you required more than 14 hours per week to maintain your therapy. In December 2017, the CRA backtracked on this decision, so file your receipts and get what's yours.

HOME SWEET SOLD - If you sold your home this year, make sure to designate it as your principal residence when you file your tax return. Forgetting this step could mean the principal residence exemption gets denied, and the capital gain from the sale would be taxed as income.

GET SOME CREDIT FOR BEING KIND - Made a charitable contribution this year? If you haven't claimed the charitable donations tax credit after 2007, any cash donations you make after March 20, 2013 (including donations you made in 2017) are eligible for the first-time donor super credit. This means you can access an additional 25% credit on your first \$1,000 of donations. Cha-ching!

FILING IS ALWAYS A GOOD IDEA, ESPECIALLY FOR TEENS - If you turn 19 before April 1, 2019, make sure you file a 2017 income tax return so you can get the GST/HST credit. You'll get at least one GST/HST Credit cheque for the payment dates following your birthday. For example, if you turn 19 in March 2019, you'll receive the last quarterly payment for the July 2018 to June 2019 benefit period, which is paid in April 2019.

AVOID EXTRA FEES BY FILING ON TIME - Make sure you file your tax return on time, especially if you have a balance due. Even if you know you won't be able to pay your tax bill right away, filing on time means you'll at least avoid the late filing penalty (a.k.a. having to pay even more tomorrow than you today). Putting off filing adds up fast, and is currently calculated as 5% of your balance due, plus 1% per month for a maximum of 12 months.

NOT WORKING 20 HOURS A WEEK FOR THE FAMILY BUSI-NESS? - Income sprinkling is a strategy some business owners used to split funds to their family members. New rules that came in on Dec 13 now require this income to be taxed at the top rate, unless the family member made a reasonable contribution to the business. If you're issuing dividends to any adults 18 or over, be sure you can qualify that they made a substantial contribution to the company, at least 20 hours per week, either during the year or any of the preceding five years.
