



No longer able to find solace in the always upbeat puppet world he created, Mr. Pickles starts to veer off-course, and that's when the comedy starts here-the "dark comedy" that is, especially when his father sees the approaching train of financial and emotional disaster and decides to market Mr. Pickles dolls, sanction a Japanese version of the Mr. Pickles show, as well as a Stars on Ice version-and eventually plans to replace Mr. Pickles with a cartoon version of "Mr. Pickles Puppet Time". It's a fact that Canada's own Jim Carrey is a living legend, a Renaissance man at whatever he does; actor,

c o m e d i a n , impressionist, screenwriter, m u s i c i a n , producer and painter-that's all him. Plus, it takes a special actor to pull off so many more serious roles effortlessly, especially when one is usually associated with

more over-the-top and silly characters such as "Ace Ventura", "Dumb and Dumber" and in the TV series "In Living Color".

Jim Carrey excelled in those roles-and he does the same here. Imagine a character that is so laid-back and casual that he makes Mr. Rogers look and sound like a speed freak; now imagine that same character unraveling when so many people depend on him for their livelihood, and his putting on a brave face and sucking up those negative feelings and emotions-even as he's dving emotionally. This series is great-one of the best I've seen in years, and I'm not kidding about that.

TAX TIPS COLUMN

Do you know you can deduct medical travel expenses?

Do you travel to Antigonish, or maybe Halifax for medical treatment? If you have to travel at least 80 kilometres (one way) from your home to obtain medical services, you may be able to claim accommodation, meal, and parking expenses in addition to your transportation expenses as medical expenses.

There are conditions to qualify for the claim of course, but they are simply that substantially equivalent medical services were not available near your home; you took a reasonably direct travelling route; and it is reasonable, under the circumstances, for you to have travelled to that place for those medical services.

Also if a medical practitioner certifies in writing that you were incapable of travelling alone to obtain medical services, you can also claim the transportation and travel expenses of an attendant who accompanied you.

For meal and vehicle expenses, you can choose to use the detailed method or the simplified method for calculating meal and vehicle expenses. If you use the detailed method, you have to keep all receipts and records for your 12-month period. The simplified method allows you to claim a flat rate of \$17/meal, to a maximum of \$51/day (sales tax included) per person, without receipts.

To use the simplified method to determine the amount you can claim for vehicle expenses, multiply the number of kilometres by the cents/km rate from the province or territory in which the travel begins. If your travel begins in Nova Scotia, the rate is 49.5 cents per kilometer.

You must keep receipts for all accommodation expenses and you must be able to show that the amount paid for accommodation is necessary because of the distance travelled and your medical condition. Claim the amount for accommodation as shown on your receipts and keep them in case the CRA asks to see them.
