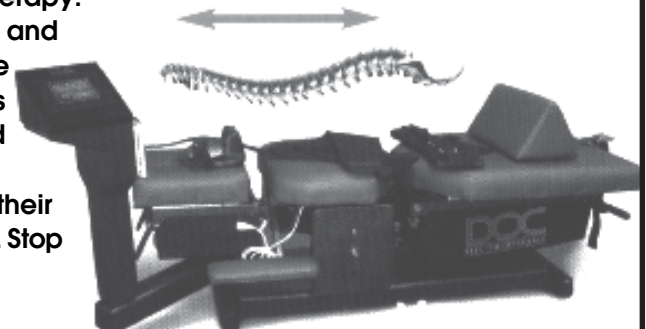

St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church to Welcome the Canadian Celtic Choir

The Canadian Celtic Choir is a London-based SATB choir of more than fifty voices and was founded in 1996 to sing and promote Celtic choral music and culture in Southwestern Ontario. They have opened for the Men of The Deeps, The Irish Descendants, John McDermott, Lighthouse, and John Tesh.

In March 2007, the Canadian Celtic Choir was the first choral group to be selected from outside of the Ottawa area to sing at a National Ceremony of Remembrance. They sang at the 90th Anniversary of the Battle of Vimy Ridge Service at the National War Memorial in Ottawa (and it was broadcast on national television).

The choir's repertoire features songs primarily from Ireland, Scotland, England, Wales, and the Canadian Maritimes ranging from the traditional (including a few songs sung in Irish, Gaelic and Welsh) to the more contemporary. One of their arrangements is the famous "Sonny's Dream" by the late Ron Hynes. The choir has been performing high quality choral music for over 20 years in the London area.

The group has travelled to Hawaii, Scotland, England and this summer will be touring the Maritimes. On Wednesday, June 28 at 7:00 p.m. St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church in Sydney Mines will warmly welcome this fantastic group to perform a beautiful concert with special guests Cora Contabula. Some of the familiar songs you will hear on that evening will be Farewell to Nova Scotia, Danny Boy, Fare Thee Well Love and many many more.

Centennial Copper Box Time Capsule

It's not Capt. Kidd's treasure or an Oak Island mystery, but this next story is one you may be able to help solve.

On July 1st, 1967, North Sydney celebrated the centennial year by opening a time capsule, which was created and designed by my grandfather, Charles B. Musgrave. My father, Cecil G. Musgrave, Sr. approached North Sydney Mayor and council in 1967 to prepare for the opening of the box. At the time, no one recollected the box but finally at the persistence of my father, it was located in the vault of the Bank of Nova Scotia, North Sydney.



My grandfather placed a number of items and papers in the copper box he handmade. He engraved instructions on the box to be opened on the Town's celebrations of the centennial year. His widow, Mabel I. Musgrave opened the box which contained many items of historic value to the Town. My father, along with my siblings was present for the occasion.

After the box was emptied, the Town officials filled the box with items of historic value to represent the year 1967. My father, Cecil G. Musgrave, Sr. placed a sealed letter with photos inside the box addressed to his infant son, Cecil G. Musgrave, Jr. The box was sealed to be opened in 50 years - which is July 1st, 2017. Because my grandfather created this copper box, the Mayor asked attending Musgrave's to open the box in 2017, namely Cecil Jr.

The copper box was again sealed and placed back in the vault of Bank of Nova Scotia. My father is deceased but before passing he asked we ensure North Sydney is reminded of the copper box and his request my youngest brother open the box. Cecil Musgrave, Jr. is prepared to attend this event along with our siblings.

Since the Town of North Sydney has amalgamated into Cape Breton Regional Municipality, we are writing to the CBRM Council to locate the box and advise us of any ceremony to celebrate opening the box. I await your reply with information on the copper box.

Chuck Berry - "Chuck" - The world lost the true king of rock and roll in March of this year; Chuck Berry has been credited by the likes of The Rolling Stones, Bruce Springsteen, The Beatles and countless other rock and roll

pioneers as such. I read an in-depth story recently in Rolling Stone magazine that stated for all intents and purposes that Chuck Berry was a very hard



person to get along with, had a shady past, and burned many bridges over the years-but none could deny the fact that he invented rock and roll music. This is a bittersweet release as it's been 38 years since Chuck Berry released an album, and this is his last. Recording for this one was completed on schedule before Chuck's death, for which his estate was prepared; three days after his death (on March 18th) it was announced that the album would be released on June 16, 2017.

Also on that day Chuck Berry's first single in 40 years hit the airwaves; "Big Boys" is a signature Chuck Berry song that's a blast back in time to the heyday of oldies rock and roll, and is a wicked tune all about a teenager wanting to do all the

things that the big boys do. Even more significant is the sequel song "Lady B. Goode" which is almost a carbon copy of the original song, but has enough of a new vibe to make it an instant classic. As for the other songs here, "Wonderful Woman" is an updated homage to his wife of 68 years (the first song was, of course "Little Queenie"). There

is a live version of the borderline silly, but so enjoyable "3/4 time" and "You Go To My Head" is a number dipped in bourbon and smoke-making it sound steamy and sultry. On a different note

"Darlin" is a slow jam that sounds like an old country/honky-tonk standard, which Berry wrote for his daughter, and "Jamaica Moon" is a rum-heavy ditty, complete with 'ya mon' Rasta style vocals.

One of the most heartfelt songs on the album is "She Still Loves You", which comes across as personal and intimate, complete with Chuck Berry's signature guitar solos. The album closes off with the number "Eyes Of A Man" and it's a fitting close on the final chapter of the music of Charles Edward Anderson Berry-born on October 18th, 1926 and died on March 18th, 2017.

Chuck can duke it out in the great beyond with Elvis Presley for who truly owns the King of Rock and Roll title-my money is on Berry to win by a TKO.
