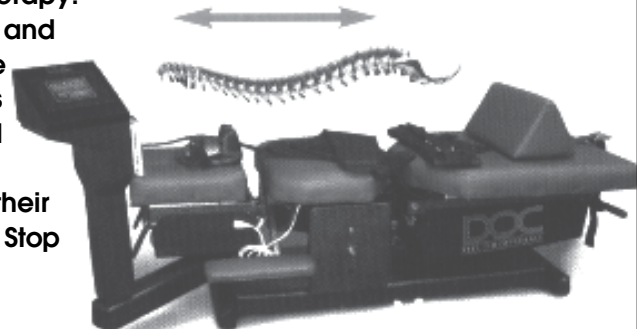

TAX TIPS 2017

TOP TAX MYTHS - "If I receive a tax refund, my return is approved"

The Facts: It feels like all is said and done when you receive a refund from the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA); but in reality, they actually have 3 years to review your return and request follow up paperwork. If your tax return ends up getting reviewed, that could result in receiving a Notice of Reassessment with a potential balance owing. "But how could this happen?!" you wonder... Let's say you packed up and moved in with your best friend who lives a few blocks away, and claimed some moving expenses for the truck you rented. Moving expenses can only be claimed if you moved at least 40 KM closer to a new place of work or school, so the CRA would refuse your claim and send you a tax bill for whatever you originally deducted.

Myth: "I earned less than \$10,000 so I don't have to file a tax return"

The Facts: If you didn't earn a ton of cash this year, or even if you had no income at all, you may still want to file a return. The good news? You probably don't owe any money. However, you still need to file a tax return, as you could be entitled to other credits and benefits that get triggered once you do file. For example, once you turn 19, you qualify for the quarterly GST/HST amount! Plus, if you did earn a little income, when you file your tax return you will likely get a refund if your employer withheld any taxes.

Myth: "I work for myself so I can write it off"

The Facts: Even if you're the boss of you and are probably working around the clock, not everything you buy can be claimed as a business expense. So what's allowed? The CRA is okay with reasonable business expenses that you might have incurred to earn your income. Keyword here being reasonable. Let's say you work from home and have one internet connection. Though you probably use a good chunk of your internet time working, the CRA will expect there to be some personal use as well (hello, Netflix). So, you can't claim 100 per cent of that expense.

Myth: "My pets are considered my dependants so I can claim their pet food"

The Facts: Unfortunately, the CRA doesn't usually recognize fur babies as dependants. But there are exceptions! If your pet is working 9 to 5 just like you, you may be able to claim their costs. A farmer was once allowed to claim cat and dog food because they were outdoor pets that were acquired to keep wildlife away from their blueberries. Myth: deduction"

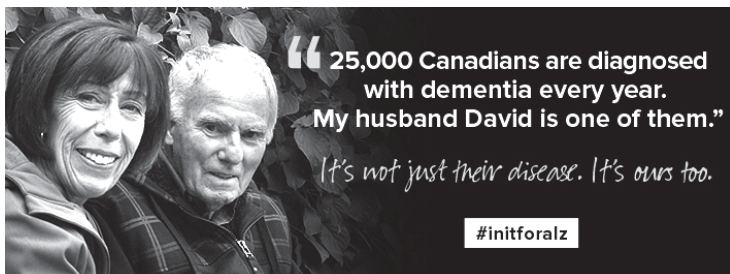

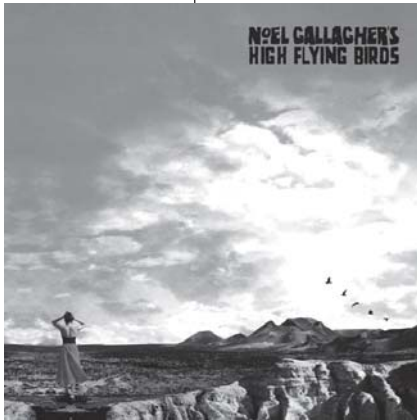

A Strong Voice for Cape Breton

Noel Gallagher's High Flying Birds - "Who Built The Moon" - Even though this is my first review for 2018 I'm looking back to the end of November when Noel Gallagher (Oasis) released album number 3 for his band Noel Gallagher's High Flying Birds. A lot of people know that I named brother Liam Gallagher's "On Your Way" album as the best album released in



2017-it is indeed that good, so it's pretty hard to listen to this release without Liam's spectacular efforts casting a giant shadow over it. Even as far back as their early years brothers Liam and Noel were like fire and gasoline, with that animosity eventually tearing Oasis apart, but Liam claimed in December that they called a truce-which is good, but given the Gallagher brothers temperament, I wouldn't bet on it lasting long.

The first single released from this album was "Holy Mountain", and it does remind us just how much Noel contributed to Oasis's famous sound; this song could easily pass for an earlier Oasis number, complete with an amped-up overdrive sound reminiscent of the best of glam rock. That Oasis vibe shows up again on "The Man Who Built The Moon" and a bit on "God Help Us", but that's about it-the rest of the album walks a different path. The second single "It's a Beautiful

World" sounds more like an INXS number, and fans of U.K. music will no doubt pick up on hints of The Chemical Brothers (on the album's opening track "Fort Knox") and the band Primal Scream on some tracks here, again with a good mix of glam rock and a bit of psychedelic on numbers such as "Black and White Sunshine" and "She Taught Me How To Fly".

Noel did have a few big name musicians helping out on recording this collection, with Paul Weller (The Jam/The Style Council) and Johnny Marr (The Smiths) being the most notable.

The album did debut at number one on the U.K. album charts, selling 78,000 units in its first week-however Liam's album sold 103,000 units. This album was released almost 2 months after Liam's, and as mentioned earlier it is the third release for Noel and his band-whereas Liam's album was his first solo effort, so that may have helped generate more interest and curiosity. Noel has done a good job here, but the songs pale in comparison to the truly awesome numbers his brother released weeks beforehand.

Liam Gallagher was indeed the heart and soul of Oasis; this album by brother Noel Gallagher unfortunately comes in a distant second place.

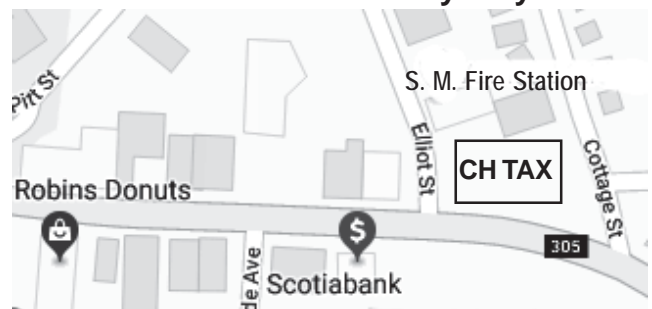
